This special issue contains a part of papers presented at the 1st Russian-Ukrainian-Polish Conference on Molecular Interactions held at Gdańsk-Sobieszewo on June 10–16, 2001. Organized on the initiative of the Physical Organic Chemistry Section of Polish Chemical Society and Gdańsk University, the Conference continued the tradition of the hydrogen-bond meetings that helped to forge links between scientists from Poland and the countries of the former Soviet Union. On the Russian side, Professor N.D. Sokolov played a significant role in this very fruitful cooperation. Sadly, however, he passed away shortly before this Conference. We devote this issue to his memory.

This meeting was realized due to the generous funding by the Polish State Committee for Scientific Research and the Polish Ministry of National Education and, due to the commitment and encouragement of the Faculty of Chemistry of Gdańsk University, the Gdańsk Scientific Society, the Foundation for the Development of Gdańsk University, and the Faculty of Chemistry of Wrocław University.

This issue proves that a sufficiently quick publication of papers in English from different East European countries is possible. Maybe this could encourage a discussion about usefulness of the creation of an East European Chemical Journal, as a supplement to the joint chemical journals created in recent years by West European Chemical Societies.
