## **Editorial Announcement**

Copyright Transfer Agreement

Under the terms of the new US copyright law, effective from January 1st, 1978, we are required specifically to obtain copyright transfer from authors of each paper in order to allow us to continue our previous practice of holding copyright on individual articles published in our journals. This will allow IPC to sanction reprints and photocopies and to authorize the reprint of complete issues or volumes according to demand. The new requirement is necessary because of the change in the US Federal Law. It does not change in any essential way this Company's relationship with authors.

As authors, you will continue to have the same rights that you previously have enjoyed. These are: the right to make oral presentation of the same or similar information in any forum; the right to reproduce figures, tables and extracts from the article with proper acknowledgement; the right to reproduce the article in small quantities for any personal non-commercial use with proper acknowledgement; the right to deny any subsequent commercial use; any proprietary rights, other than copyright, including the right to any patentable subject matter that might be contained in the article.

We therefore ask you to sign and mail the Copyright Transfer Form below (containing an original signature) preferably with your original manuscript at the time of submission to the address below.

- The Right to use all or part of this article in future works of their own, such as lectures, reviews or textbooks.
