Polymer Bulletin will have four new features:

- Online system for manuscript submission and editorial processing
- Online publication within two weeks from acceptance
- Overall publication time of 2-3 months
- Page limit increased to 12 pages

Beginning in July 2004 Springer will introduce an *online system for manuscript submission and editorial processing*. With ManuscriptCentral, all processing of Polymer Bulletin manuscripts, from submittal to acceptance for publication, is exclusively electronic and online. The author's initial submittal of a manuscript is online. The Editor and reviewers all retrieve the manuscript online, the author receives the reviewer's comments and the publication decision by e-mail and submits a revised manuscript online, and the final accepted manuscript is also forwarded to the publisher online. Everyone has access to the same online system. The new steps announced here make processing of a Polymer Bulletin manuscript, from submittal to publication, completely electronic.

Please note that you still have to use our *Word template* for creating the camera-ready layout. Only then can we guarantee the fast publication time.

These new arrangements should provide several advantages: mailing and courier costs are reduced for authors and Polymer Bulletin staff, because most transactions now occur online. The length of time between manuscript submittal and publication decision will be shorter because not only will manuscript transactions be transported nearly instantaneously, but also all transactions will be carefully tracked by the Polymer Bulletin Editorial Offices. These offices will prompt all reviewers to keep to promised completion schedules for each review step on each manuscript and each author to keep the given time for revision (2 weeks for minor and 8 weeks for major revision). In total we will publish a manuscript from submission by the author until publication within 2-3 months.

Logging into MC for electronic manuscript submission is simple. Online, connect to: http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/polbul

The first time you do this, please check for an existing account. Click the "check for existing account" button. If an account exists, you will then receive an automatic email containing your user ID and password. If no account exists, please click "create a new account" and follow the instructions given on the screen and a new user ID and password will be e-mailed to you.

Once you have an account, simply type your user ID and password and MC will open for you. Complete instructions and help regarding online submittal of a manuscript can be found in MC. After logging in, authors may submit a new manuscript or track a previously submitted manuscript, and reviewers may open and download a manuscript for review. The access a user has to information in MC depends on the role(s) the user is assigned. Authors may only view some information regarding their own manuscript, reviewers may access the manuscript and review forms, Editors may view all information for all manuscripts.

If for some reason the author cannot access ManuscriptCentral they are asked to send electronic file using our templates for Polymer Bulletin so that this file may be submitted online by the Administrative Office instead of the author.

In addition to the print and electronic version of your paper we will have it *Online First*. Immediately after the acceptance of your paper it will be processed for the online first version. Provided you use our templates, your paper will be published electronically within two weeks and will be citable by using the DOI.

The Editors and the Publisher decided to increase the maximum *number of pages* per article from 8 to 12.
