The D. I. Mendeleev Gold Medal is awarded for the most outstanding works in the field of chemical science and engineering.

Papers should be submitted by November 7, 1997.

The V. G. Khlopin Prize is awarded for prominent works in the field of radiochemistry.

Papers should be submitted by October 26, 1997.

The S. V. Lebedev Prize is awarded for the best works in the field of chemistry and technology of synthetic rubber and other synthetic polymers.

Papers should be submitted by April 25, 1998.

The M. M. Shemyakin Prize is awarded for the most notable works in the field of bioorganic chemistry.

Papers should be submitted by April 26, 1998.

The I. P. Bardin Prize is awarded for the most outstanding works in the field of metallurgy.

Papers should be submitted by August 13, 1998.

The P. A. Rebinder Prize is awarded for the most notable works in the field of colloidal chemistry and the chemistry of surface phenomena.

Papers should be submitted by July 3, 1998.

The A. A. Balandin Prize is awarded for the best works in the field of catalysis.

Papers should be submitted by September 20, 1998.
