Deposition of Data with the Cambridge Crystallographic Data Centre

Authors are requested to take *full* responsibility for the deposition of data for crystal structures containing organic carbon (except for protein and other macromolecules).

- All papers presenting crystal structure(s) must carry the following statement:
 "Atomic coordinates for this structure have been deposited with the
 Cambridge Crystallographic Data Centre. The coordinates can be obtained on
 request from The Director, Cambridge Crystallographic Data Centre, Uni versity Chemical Laboratory, Lensfield Road, Cambridge CB2 1EW, U.K."
- 2. Both a paged reprint of the paper and a copy of the data for deposition must be sent by the author to the CCDC as soon as the paper is published and *not* before.
- 3. If the data are not presented in the printed publication the following data are required for deposition:
 - (a) crystal data; (b) bond lengths and bond angles (these are used for checking the atomic coordinates); (c) chemical structural diagram.
- 4. The following data are not accepted for deposition but should be sent to The British Library Lending Division, Boston Spa, Wetherby, West Yorks LS23 7BQ, U.K.:
 - (a) thermal parameters; (b) structure factors; (c) torsion angles and non-bonded distances.
