MULTIPLICITY OF STEROID-HORMONE RECEPTORS

Time: 23 June 1977; 2-6 p.m. Place: The University, Lausanne, Switzerland

The workshop is intended mainly to discuss the role, the appearance, and the significance of the multiple peaks, evident during physical fractionation of cytoplasmic and nuclear proteins, that exhibit receptor activity for steroid hormones.
