

## Erratum

In the article by Richter et al., in the March 1999 issue of the *Journal* (“Location Score and Haplotype Analyses for Autosomal Recessive Spastic Ataxia of Charlevoix-Saguenay, in Chromosome Region 13q11” [99: 768–775]), there were three errors on page 770: (1) in the third line of the “Location Scores and Haplotypes of the ARSACS Candidate-Gene Region” subsection, there should be a right (i.e., closing) parenthesis after “Lange 1997”; (2) the second sentence of the first paragraph of the “Results” section should be “A LOD score

$\leq -2$  for a  $\theta$  in the range .01–.2 was obtained for 121 microsatellite loci”; and (3) in the seventh line of the second paragraph of the “Results” section,  $\hat{\theta}$  should be defined as “the maximum-likelihood estimate of  $\theta$ ” (rather than as “maximum  $\theta$ ”). In addition, on page 773, in the paragraph that begins in the right-hand column, the first sentence should read as follows: “The haplotypes in the large group that contain either allele *D13S292*\*2 or allele *D13S787*\*3 are not obviously recombinant haplotypes.” The *Journal* regrets these errors.
