

## Erratum

*Corrected Erratum (supersedes the previous version, published in the February 2000 issue)*

Some errors appeared in the article “Genome Scan for Human Obesity and Linkage to Markers in 20q13,” by Lee et al., published in the January 1999 issue of the *Journal* (64:196–209). Because of a programming mistake in an automated procedure for collation of the *t* scores, some EMHE results were incorrectly reported as significant when they were not; these errors occurred in the following parts of the article: table 2 (markers

D2S439, D7S817, D8S560, D16S539, D20S200, and D20S107), table 3 (markers D20S471, D20S200, and D20S107), figure 2 (“----BMI (EMHE),” entire curve), and figure 3 (“----% fat (EMHE),” from D20S116 to D20S107). Similar errors in the collation of the simulation results may have resulted in a slight inflation of estimated *P* values, causing reported empirical significance levels to be too conservative. Errors with regard to chromosome 20 affected only the centromeric markers, not our major linkage findings in 20q13.
