

Announcement for CISM course "Adhesive Bonding Science and Technology"

The course "Adhesive Bonding Science and Technology" will be held at CISM (International Centre for Mechanical Sciences) in Udine (Italy) from October 4–8, 2010. The course is coordinated by Lucas F. M. da Silva (University of Porto, Portugal) and Andreas Öchsner (Technical University of Malaysia, Malaysia). It is a 30h course with the following lecturers: Maurice Brogly (University of Haute Alsace, France, 5 Fundamentals of Adhesion), Gary W. Critchlow lectures on (Loughborough University, UK, 5 lectures on Surface Preparation), Lucas F. M. da Silva (University of Porto, Portugal, 5 lectures on Adhesive Properties), Liyong Tong (The University of Sydney, Australia, 5 lectures on Joint Design by Analytical Approaches), Andreas Ochsner (Technical University of Malaysia, Malaysia, 5 lectures on Joint Design by the Finite Element Method) and Ian Ashcroft (Loughborough University, UK, 5 lectures on Joint Performance in Service Environments).

Applicants must apply at least one month before the beginning of the course.

If you need assistance with registration please contact the CISM secretariat. The 700.00 Euro registration fee includes a complimentary bag, four fixed menu buffet lunches (Friday not included), hot beverages, on-line/downloadable lecture notes and wi-fi internet access. A limited number of participants from universities and research centers who are not supported by their own institutions can be offered board and/or lodging in a reasonably priced hotel. Requests should be sent to CISM Secretariat by July 28, 2010 along with the applicant's curriculum vitae and a letter of recommendation by the head of the department or a supervisor confirming that the institute cannot provide funding. Preference will be given to applicants from countries that sponsor CISM.
