Theoretical Aspects of Medicinal Chemistry

A symposium on the above subject will be held at the Joint Central–Great Lakes Regional American Chemical Society Meeting at Butler University, Indianapolis, Indiana, USA, May 24–26, 1978. Invited lectures, arranged by Dr. D. B. Boyd, Lilly Research Laboratories, will deal with molecular orbital and other studies directed toward understanding disease processes at the molecular level and designing suitable therapeutic agents to interfere with those processes. Computational methods for large molecules and investigations of structure-activity relationships will be of interest. Contributed papers on any of these topics are welcome. Also at the meeting there will be symposia on Solvent Effects on Molecular Structure and Energetics, Electronic Spectra of Inorganic Molecules, and Motions in Proteins.
