

Phoma Lingam-diseased Control Plant and Healthy Plant Regenerated from Selected Cell Cultures of Rape

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In Fig. 6 of my paper "Selection of *Brassica napus* in vitro cultures for resistance to *Phoma lingam*" in volume 61 of this journal, page 195, 1982, the "corking" symptom at base of stem in the diseased plant (left), indicated in the text of the figure, is not to recognize at all because of the size reduction.

The editors have agreed to reproduce once more this figure in its original size: the symptoms in the diseased plant (left), corking and collapsed leaves, can be now seen more clearly. Both plants were inoculated at the same time with the same spore suspension.

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
