## Electronic Structure and Properties of Polymers

A NATO Advanced Study Institute on "Electronic Structure and Properties of Polymers" will be held from September 1 to 14, 1977, at the "Facultés Universitaires Notre-Dame de la Paix", Namur, Belgium, under the joint sponsorship of the Scientific Affairs Division of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization and of the "Facultés Universitaires Notre-Dame de la Paix".
