The 11th Jerusalem Symposium

An International Symposium on:

Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Spectroscopy in Molecular Biology

sponsored by the Institut de Biologie Physico-Chimique (Fondation Edmond de Rothschild), Paris, will be held, under the auspices of the Israel Academy of Sciences and Humanities and of the Hebrew University, in Jerusalem, Israel, from April 3rd to April 7th, 1978.

The aim of this meeting will be the confrontation of the present status of our knowledge about the theoretical and experimental aspects of the problem. Attention will be paid to the role of quantum-mechanical computations in this field. The collaboration of both theoreticians and experimentalists is therefore welcome at this Symposium.
