Quantum Chemistry of Polymers; Solid State Aspects

A NATO Advanced Study Institute on "Quantum Chemistry of Polymers; Solid State Aspects" will be held from July 25–August 5, 1983, at Braunlage/Harz, West Germany, under the sponsorship of the Scientific Affairs Division of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization.

The objective of this ASI is to bring together quantum chemists as well as theoretical and experimental physicists to review the application of quantum mechanical and experimental methods for the description of the electronic structure of different polymers and their properties. At the School besides theoreticians, we shall have also a few outstanding experimentalists as Main Lecturers to review the different experimental aspects of the problem.
