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Erratum to: Theor Chem Acc

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Due to an error that occurred at the stage of correction of the galley proofs, the sentence in the middle section of the left column of page 7, stating

“The curves for para-H₂ and ortho-D₂ are straight lines in a reciprocal-*T* plot at constant *P*, and for H₂Δ*n*_{3:1} is almost superimposed on the Δ*n*_v curve in the interval of temperatures (inset of Fig. 1). Differences between Δ*n*_{2:1} and Δ*n*_v at low temperatures are somewhat larger for the deuterium molecule.”

is partly incorrect. It should read

“The curves for para-H₂ and ortho-D₂ are straight lines in a reciprocal-*T* plot at constant *P*, and for H₂Δ*n*_p is almost superimposed on the Δ*n*_v curve in the interval of temperatures in the inset of Fig. 1. Differences between Δ*n*_o and Δ*n*_v at low temperatures are somewhat larger for the deuterium molecule.”
