Call for nominations for the ICTAC Awards

Nominations are requested for the ICTAC TA Instruments and Young Scientist Awards which will be presented at the 11th International Conference on Thermal Analysis in Philadelphia, USA, 12–16 August 1996.

TA Instruments Award

This consists of a plaque, an honorarium of US \$1000, and expenses to attend the Philadelphia meeting. It is awarded to a person who has, in the judgement of the Awards Committee and Council of ICTAC, made an outstanding contribution to the science of thermal analysis and/or shown significant leadership to the profession of thermal analysis. Nominations should include the consent of the candidate, curriculum vitae, list of publications, and other relevant supporting material. Five copies of the nomination portfolio should be provided.

Young Scientist Award

This consists of a plaque and the necessary financial support to attend the Philadelphia meeting. Candidates, who must be under 35 years of age on 31 December 1996, should submit the paper that they intend to present at the meeting, together with a list of publications and a short curriculum vitae. The paper must be in English and the candidate must be the sole author. Five copies of the documentation should be provided.

Nominations for both Awards should be sent to arrive by 31 August 1995.
