Fast forward three months to April and, as I type, travel plans, along with other plans, have been put on hold for us all.



CORNISH TIPI WEDDINGS, ST KEW

This quirky venue is located in a secret woodland valley situated just five minutes from the wild Atlantic coast and surrounded by 16 acres of countryside blooming with wild ferns, bluebells, ancient oaks and meadowsweet. There's a shimmering lake at the heart of it where ceremonies can take place by the water's edge. A romantic idea at dusk is to host a Festival of Light ceremony with floating candles and flowers

Ceremonies are also conducted in the fully licensed wedding pavilion made from wood, willow and canvas, set deep in the heart of the secret valley by a clear brook. It seats up to 50 guests inside, with space for a further 50 loved ones outside on the decking. For larger weddings of more than 100 people, additional seating can be arranged outside. Straw bales covered with coloured rugs are a great way of accommodating larger numbers.

Post-ceremony drinks and canapés take place in the largest tipi structure, the Grand Lodge. It seats up to 20 guests or hosts up to 50 loved ones standing and is located in a woodland clearing. The purpose-built Safari tent marquee can seat up to 250 guests for the wedding breakfast and reception and sits on a wooden deck in a grassy meadow with room on the marquee lawn for guests to enjoy the great outdoors. There's the option of a barbecue or a woodland picnic, and weddings can be suitably themed, for example, a Mad Hatter's Tea Party. The firepit adds a romantic ambience at dusk, with guests toasting marshmallows, lighting sparklers and star-gazing.

The new Mr & Mrs can spend their wedding night in a tipi situated on a private site, and guests will receive a wedding guest discount when booking overnight accommodation in an on-site tipi.




THE CASTLE BUDE

This historic castle is a Grade II listed building nestled in dunes next to Summerleaze Beach and runs alongside the Bude Canal. It offers a relaxed and friendly venue with unrivalled views, stunning grounds, and a sweeping driveway, all ideal for big-day photos.

Ceremonies take place in a choice of three areas. The Willoughby Gallery is the largest room overlooking the castle

grounds seating up to 60 guests. The Blanchminster Gallery can seat up to 16 loved ones and also boasts beautiful views, and there's also the Conservatory Room with views stretching across the Atlantic Ocean that also accommodates up to 16 guests.

Buffet-style receptions are held in the Willoughby Gallery for up to 40 seated guests or up to 80 standing. There's a second, smaller room available best suited to a more intimate 20 seated guests or 30 standing.



CAERHAYS ESTATE, ST AUSTELL

Tucked in a hidden Cornish cove on the unspoilt Porthluney Beach and hugged by woodland spring gardens sits this stunning coastal wedding venue.

Ceremonies take place in The Coastguards Lookout, a small, historic building hosting up to 20 nearest and dearest. Situated on the rural headland overlooking the coast, it offers stunning views over Veryan Bay and beyond, and the backdrop presents the perfect spot for photographs. There's also the opportunity for pictures to be taken down on the beach after the ceremony at no extra cost.

Alternatively, The Vean is a beautifully restored Georgian manor house nestled in the Porthluney valley that's licensed for ceremonies and can be hired exclusively. Couples can choose to host a private dinner the night before the wedding, and a marquee

can be erected on the lawn just outside seating up to 150 guests for the wedding breakfast and reception. There's also the option of using the terrace marquee attached to the side of the Vean to seat up to 70 loved ones. The house offers luxury accommodation with up to 16 guests staying in eight stylish bedrooms.

St Michael's Caerhays Church situated in Caerhays Village, a few minutes walk from The Vean, is another ceremony option, and outdoor ceremonies can also take place at Beach Meadow, a beachside marquee location. Receptions for up to 250 guests can take place here, overlooking Porthluney Cove Beach with access to the water's edge via a footpath. The site has disabled access and ample parking.

The Castle Field is another impressive location for the reception in a marquee for up to 250 guests, with views of the castle and lake.







LUSTY GLAZE BEACH WEDDINGS, NEWQUAY

This rustic, laidback venue is situated on its private beach in a secluded cove on the North Cornish coast and has been designed to reflect its surroundings with a restaurant, two bars, the Top Deck ceremony area and clear-fronted marquee allowing for panoramic views stretching across the Atlantic Ocean. KNIGHTOR WINERY, TRETHURGY, CORNWALL

Knightor is a beautiful courtyard of historic and traditionally restored granite barns with an adjoining farmhouse used for on-site accommodation.

The winery is set in four acres of vineyards, pasture and orchard in a secluded area of countryside nestled just above St Austell Bay. The grounds include a sunny courtyard perfect for drinks and dining al fresco, pretty cottage gardens that surround the farmhouse and lead to the arbour, and a wildlife pond which is a stunning outdoor blessing location.

The main Threshing Barn comprises an oak-topped barrel bar, comfy sofas and a dancefloor on the ground floor, with doors leading out to the sunny courtyard. On the second floor, the large room filled with natural daylight has vaulted ceilings, oak beams and stone walls offering a traditional Cornish barn feel.

It's a peaceful spot for small and large gatherings, and the nearby pond makes a wonderful photo opportunity in summer when it's topped with lily pads and surrounded by bulrushes and wildflowers. Blessings can take place here, as well as in the orchard and vine polytunnel, and it's also a

superb spot for drinks and canapés.

The wedding breakfast and reception takes place in the Threshing Barn for up to 120 guests seated, or 160 loved ones standing during the evening. Guests have the option to relax upstairs with dancing taking place downstairs, and the venue benefits from a late licence.

For those wanting to host all of their celebrations outside, the courtyard can be set up for outdoor dining for up to 120 guests seated at long banquet tables in addition to the top table. It's also a great spot for a drinks reception and looks romantic at night decorated with festoon lighting and bunting. Within the courtyard, there's a small lawn, ideal for a spot of croquet. A marquee can be erected in the courtyard and orchard, and guests can enjoy the accommodation available in the farmhouse, or, tipis or yurts can be hired and pitched in the orchard for more accommodation options.





SETTING THE SCENE



A part of the day that stood out for Rich was turning to see me walking down the aisle with my dad.







Rich wore his military uniform and, together with his sword party, they all stood out.



"With our weddings we, like many other catering companies, offer a bespoke service but we take it one step further, not only writing menus for our wedding couples but also growing our produce and rearing livestock for their dishes too," owners Victoria and Dean Dawes tell us. "We like to work about 16 months in advance with this service so that we can plan the polytunnels and raised beds for growing the produce."

Victoria and Dean have worked with some very varied menus using this service, one of the most memorable at a wedding at Bre-Pen farm near Mawgan Porth in Cornwall where the couple wanted their wedding meal to tell the story of their travels around the world. "It featured influences from countries such as Cambodia, Argentina, Vietnam, Brasil and Korea to name but a few," Victoria and Dean tell us. "They wanted Korean barbecues in the middle of each table so that guests could cook their meat and fish, as well as an entire goat cooked over a fire. We sourced the meat and fish locally using alpaca meat from Moorfield farm in Bodmin for one of the South American dishes, and a goat from our herd. We did run into a few problems with the planning! Because it was under canvas and on National Trust land, we couldn't use coal for the Korean barbecue for insurance reasons, so we adapted their wish and came up with some different suggestions including teppanyaki grills which involved having a bespoke wiring system made to run them all."

TOP TIP: "There hasn't been a request that we have not been able to manage to fulfil and we have had a few strange ones such as using a JCB to cut the wedding cake! So let your imagination run wild and link your food to your theme, and don't be afraid to get in touch!" - Victoria and Dean

We're rescheduling our wedding until spring 2021 so can you give me some ideas for bridal dress trends that look set to continue throughout the rest of this year and into next?

Sarah says: Colour still features strongly on the bridal catwalks as an alternative to the traditional white and ivory gowns. Blush, beige and pink have been evident for the past few seasons so expect this to continue, but now expanding into the palette are shades of blue,

pistachio, and green. The use of colour isn't limited to subtle tints, instead, bold floral prints and coloured embroidery can also be expected to make an appearance, inspired by nature and romantic painterly watercolours. This artistic, artisanal trend is evident in other forms of fabric embellishments. Large, luscious ruffles, intricate pleating, silk abstract flowers and soft chiffon feathers give an innovative twist to classic shapes, all expected to be requested for weddings taking place in 2021. The recent popularity of period dramas



such as *Emma*, *Belgravia* and *Little Women* has also influenced bridal trends this season. High necklines, lace bodices and long lace sleeves are given a more modern feel with the seductive baring of backs and shoulders. Lace is ever-present, but expect a bolder take on this favourite fabric. Instead of soft delicate Chantilly lace, think heavy, corded varieties and guipure lace that resembles crochet. Upcoming trends will also see cheeky high splits, short asymmetric hems, and the popular monochrome look of black teamed with traditional ivory. There's also simple tailoring with jackets, trousers, and jumpsuits all beautifully cut and unadorned, and coat-style dresses and capes. I'd sum up the new season as being strong yet feminine, creative and bold with a liberal sprinkling of irreverent attitude.

Bespoke designs

Creating these is my most requested service. Most couples that I work with love to know that their wedding stationery will be unique and has had a lot of time and effort put into making it truly special.

Wedding venue illustrations

This is something that I love doing and find that I am being asked to do more of, especially watercolour paintings or line drawings of the couple's chosen wedding venue that features throughout their wedding stationery. Also, a framed, personalised version featuring the names and wedding date in calligraphy makes the most beautiful gift or wedding keepsake.

Personalised details

Adding personalised details can create a more luxurious feel to wedding stationery. I find that I am doing more watercolour and calligraphy initial monograms and crests for wedding invitations, and the finer details include personalised wax seals and embossed envelopes.

Minimalistic designs

Many couples are requesting that their wedding stationery has a more simplistic design with the main invitation being plainer, and the information displayed on an additional details card.

Added layers and texture

One of my favourite things about creating beautiful wedding stationery is using a mix of materials in layers to add depth. From the textured card, coloured envelopes, silk ribbons, and sprigs, anything is possible! My favourite is pocket folds with a magnet and a wax seal.

Soft muted tones, or a bold, contrasting colour palette

These are the two different colour themes that I'm seeing more of at the moment and I love them both!

Calligraphy is definitely on trend and I feel it always will be. It's such a beautiful art form, adding a soft elegance to anything, and I love doing it.

We're thinking of hiring a wedding videographer – what questions should we be asking them?

Simon says: Ask your wedding venue for videographer referrals because if they have worked at the venue before, and produced high-quality films that other couples are happy with, this is a good start.

Before meeting your videographer for the first time, make sure you know what style of video you would like. This could be anything from aerial videography to a more laid-back, documentary-style film.

Find wedding videographers via hashtags on Instagram and message previous brides directly asking about their experience. Before booking, ask your chosen wedding videographer these questions:

- 1. Are you available on my wedding date?
- 2. How long have you been a wedding videographer?
- 3. What is your videography style?
- 4. Can I see one full-length example of a wedding video that you produced?
- 5. Have you ever worked with my photographer?
- 6. Have you ever filmed at my wedding venue before?
- 7. Are you the videographer who will be filming on the day?
- 8. Do you offer any videography packages?
- 9. Can I choose the music for the film?
- 10. How long will the wedding video be?
- 11. Do you offer aerial filming?
- 12. What part of the day will you capture?
- 13. How many people are on your team?
- 14. How many cameras will be operating?
- 15. Can I add a second location for you to film at? Is there an extra charge for this?
- 16. Are there any further costs than what is outlined in the package?
- 17. How long after the wedding will I receive the video?
- 18. How is the final film delivered?
- 19. Who owns the copyright to the final video?
- 20. Can I make changes once I have seen the film for the first time?
- 21. How much is the deposit? When is the remaining balance due?
- 22. What's your cancellation policy?

There's something fun about putting this purple paste on your toothbrush, and its unusual yet pleasant taste left my mouth feeling fresh and ready for the day. I was impressed at how, after just one use my teeth already seemed brighter.

THE YOUNG ONES

I'm having a mix of adult and teen bridesmaids at my wedding and the younger ones want their hair and make-up applied on the day. What can you suggest for them?

Jen says: I'm getting more enquiries for younger bridesmaids to be included in the hair and make-up schedule for the wedding morning which is fantastic because everyone should feel amazing on the day, no matter what their age.

For the younger girls, it's all about making them feel part of the wedding party and I help to enhance their natural beauty that I do for all of my clients. I pride myself on beautiful, natural make-up application, creating striking and confident brides, bridesmaids, flowergirls, and mothers. For the younger ones, it might be covering up spots and blemishes to give them confidence and adding a touch of colour to their cheeks, shimmer to their eyes and finishing with a pretty, subtle lip gloss. I will then create a complementary

hairdo that suits their face that might be a large plait or a head full of curls. Something simple, yet pretty and effective, is more likely to last all day.



INSIDER TIPS AND TRICKS

I have just become engaged and want to start thinking about my wedding make-up. Can you tell me some of the most popular questions that brides-to-be ask you as a professional make-up artist, hair stylist, and beauty therapist?

Kathryn says: Firstly, brides often enquire about whether they need to book a trial and every client that I work with gets one because they're included in my prices. I believe they're a very important factor to show each bride what they're going to look like on their wedding day. Sometimes, a client will come to see me with an idea of what they want and end up deciding on a completely different look. This is the beauty of having a trial day - you have the time to explore different ideas which is something that would not be possible on the morning of the wedding due to time constraints.

A trial works the other way, too. Brides will gain confidence in their make-up artist and build a sense of familiarity with them as a person so that when they arrive on the morning of the wedding, there's a sense of calm. My job is to create beautiful make-up while ensuring that brides can also enjoy their special morning.

Secondly, I get frequently asked about how much make-up should be applied. Many of my brides aren't used to wearing it so are apprehensive of it looking too heavy. I always advise them that they can achieve a natural look while wearing different products. Most brides want to look like themselves, just an enhanced version. However, if a bride regularly wears lots of make-up, they might not want the natural look and instead opt for a more glamorous one. This is also fine, and it's my job to listen to each client to understand how to make her feel comfortable and confident. I also specialise in HD Brows and get many enquiries about eyebrow treatments. For clients who want to grow theirs, I can put them on a plan where they have a treatment every three to four weeks, depending on how fast their brows grow, to help this. It's a long process though and can take up to one year for some to achieve their desired look so it's essential they don't pluck their brows through this period and let different areas grow back. HD brows are very popular with brides and not everyone needs a regrowth plan. If you're having a one-off treatment, I would advise this to be done three to four days before the wedding, remembering that you'll need to have a patch test 48 hours before your treatment.




NATURAL BEAUTY


wanting to know her beauty secrets and how she constantly looks so flawless."







Kelly Andrews discovers the minimoon delights of Hampshire

The more real wedding features I have the Deasure of writing, the more couples I encounter who tell me their first port of call post-wedding is to take some much-needed R&R, not in some far-flung exotic location, but here in beautiful Britain. The rise of the domestic minimoon isn't at all surprising when you consider how much this country has to offer from heritage to culture, and everything in between. After all, there's a reason we welcomed more than 29 million overseas visitors to the UK in 2019 alone. One of the most delightful and characterful regions of our stunning sceptred isle is the New Forest, thanks in no small part to the gorgeous ponies. Despite staring down 40 I still found spotting them while out and about on our travels to be great fun!

Situated in the heart of the New Forest, Balmer Lawn Hotel & Spa cuts quite an impressive figure as it comes into view on the approach to Brockenhurst. Built in the mid-1800s as a hunting lodge, it's played a part in some of history's most dramatic chapters, such as being commandeered as an army hospital in WWI. I'm always like a kid in a sweet shop when I set foot into a hotel room for the first time, and being told that I'd be treated to a luxury balcony room, my excitement levels were already off the charts. Balmer Lawn has a brilliant online booking system, whereby you can see pictures of each and every room before you book. Being the ultra-nosey person that I am, you can bet your bottom dollar I took them up on that! It's well worth checking out this feature to ensure your room has everything your heart desires, whether it's just the two of you, or if you're joined by your family or fur-baby.

The hotel offers a fabulous dining experience. I was particularly swept away by the seven-course chef's tasting menu, every bite of which was beyond delicious. Dishes included an artichoke velouté, Creedy Carver duck breast, and salted caramel fondant. With appetites well and truly satisfied, it was off to the comfortable bar and lounge for an espresso martini night cap, before reclining in front of Netflix back in our room.





Hannah Faulder finds out why the north's most lavish new hotel opening is the perfect spot to spend time with your loved one

Passing through the ornate gates and heading down the sweeping driveway, the Grade II* listed Grantley Hall appears in front of you in all its historic glory. Nestled in the idyllic countryside, the hotel and wedding venue's grounds boast a kitchen garden and an English Heritage-listed Japanese garden.

Step inside, and you'll find this stately manor has been transformed into Yorkshire's most lavish and talked-about hotel. With 47 exquisite rooms and suites, the tranquil Three Graces Spa and four incredible restaurants all in an enchanting setting, it's hard to imagine a more romantic retreat.

STAY

My sister, Laura, and I stayed in a suite in the Fountains Wing Atrium, a fabulous semi-open-air space complete with olive trees. The walk there from the reception took in some breathtaking interiors, from a showstopping contemporary chandelier and Roman-style statues to a fabulous lounge decked out in jewel-coloured décor and a cosy wine cellar complete with seating.

We were blown away by the attention to detail in our room – everything had been designed to make our stay just that bit more perfect. I've seen a pillow menu before, but a robe menu? I must admit we got quite excited about the light settings, which gave the perfect ambience for the day, evening and nighttime.

Returning to the room before bed, we were treated to a wonderful turndown service including mood lighting and classical music filling the room – the perfect bedtime ritual.

UNWIND

Laura and I are avid spa fans, so visiting the hotel's Three Graces Spa was a must. Named after Zeus' three daughters, the space evokes a Roman feel with its vaulted ceiling and

stone pillars. Appealing to the most discerning wellness-focused guests, it's a haven of serenity.

We made full use of the pool, steam room and outdoor hot tub (which included a bracing shuffle across the terrace on a cold January day). We also braved the snow room, although it turned out to be totally invigorating standing in a freezing room in your swimmers. Lunch in the spa lounge was a nutritious smoothie and bulgur wheat salad. Don't worry – there was cake too!

There's an extensive range of beauty and holistic treatments available and residents can also make use of the daily yoga sessions. In short, you cannot help but feel the weight lifting from your shoulders while you're here. How perfect would that be as a post-vow break to give you time to reflect on the most important day of your life?

EAT

There are four restaurants here encompassing everything from traditional fine dining at Shaun Rankin at Grantley Hall to modern Pan-Asian at EightyEight. We dined in Fletchers Restaurant. A wonderfully cosy space, it offers for a warm, welcoming feel. Picture dark wood-panelled walls, rich furnishings, velvet-bound menus and soft lighting. The staff were attentive, but not fussy, even checking whether I was right or left handed before placing my wine glass down. We had an incredible three-course meal including a delicious mousse starter with pickled vegetables and truffle and a deliciously fresh salad made from local produce. The star of the show was the chocolate and hazelnut rocher; it was so decadent it could only be topped off with gold leaf!






