A Study on the Heterogeneity of the Light-Harvesting Complex II from Ectothiorhodospira sp. after Acid/Chaotropic Treatment

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The light-harvesting complex II of the purple bacteria has two strong near infrared electronic absorption bands, around 800 (B800) and 850 (B850) nm, arising from the Q_y transitions of bacteriochlorophyll a. It was previously reported that under some specific acid/chaotropic conditions the B850 bacteriochlorophylls of the light-harvesting complex II of Ectothiorhodospira sp. are strongly reorganised. Part of these pigments absorbs at 843 nm

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
