GENERAL SAFETY





RESPONSIBLE PERSONNEL ACTIONS

- Reduce the exposure rate.
- Ensure that no more personnel work on an operation than are necessary.
- See that safety precautions are vigorously observed and enforced.
- Post safety signs in working area.
- Discipline careless workers and reward careful ones.
- See that no unauthorized operations are performed.
- See that all operations are properly supervised.

EQUIPMENT SAFETY



STANDING OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP)



- Safety requirements.
- Personnel and explosive limits.
- Quality control and quality assurance procedures.
- Description of work to be accomplished.
- Designation of equipment to be used.
- Location and sequence of operation.



SOP CONTINUED



- Action to be taken in event of electrical storms, utility or mechanical failures.
- SOP will be in English or the language employees can understand.
- The SOP will be approved by the commander or a qualified member of his staff.
- The SOP will also be approved by personnel designated as being responsible for performance of an operation.



SOP CONTINUED



- No change to an SOP will be permitted unless approved in writing by the approving authority.
- All personnel having operational duties or supervision thereof will enforce the SOP requirements for their particular operation and have ready access to the SOP for reference.
- Applicable portions of the approved SOP shall be conspicuously posted convenient to all stations involved in the operation for guidance of all personnel.
