# INSTALLATION AND REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE TRIMBLE TRIMPACK GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (GPS) SPECIAL MISSION KITS ON OH-58A HELICOPTERS

- 1. PRIORITY. This technical bulletin is classified ROUTINE.
- **2. PURPOSE.** This Technical Bulletin to only be applied if dictated by mission requirements. It provides instructions for the temporary Installation of provisions for a GPS Trimpack receiver on the upper center surface of the main Instrument panel glareshield in the cockpit and a remote antenna on the upper wire strike cutter. When the GPS is Installed, it will provide the copilot/observer with information on aircraft position for navigation.

**9. INSTALLATION PROCEDURES FOR KIT A.** The following procedures contain instructions for installing/removing the GPS Trimpack and provisions on OH-58A helicopters.

#### **CAUTION**

- \* To prevent damage or loss, items removed to gain access to work areas shall be tagged for identification and protected from damage before reinstallation. Retain all attaching hardware and identification markers unless otherwise directed.
- \* Ensure that a foreign object damage (FOD) prevention program Is implemented during application of this TB in accordance with AR 385-95, Chapter 4.

#### **NOTE**

- \* Refer to TM 55-1520-228-23 and TM 11-1520-228-23 for detailed removal and installation instructions not contained herein and TM 55-1520-228-23P for detailed parts location.
- \* Refer to TM 55-1500-323-24 for detailed instructions concerning aircraft electrical and electronic wiring installation practices.
- \* Refer to TM 1-1500-204-23 for detailed instructions concerning aircraft sheet metal practices.
- \* Refer to TM 55-1500-345-23 for painting and marking practices.
- \* If Trimpack Sleeve Assembly (P/N 90209-501) has not been modified, modify per Figure 8.
- a. Aircraft preparation.
  - (1) Prepare aircraft for safe ground maintenance.
  - (2) Lower overhead console circuit breaker panel for access to power distribution wiring.

- (3) Remove upper cabin sound proofing blanket as required to gain access to wire bundles and GPS antenna cable routing.
- b. Prepare upper wire strike cutter for installation of Trimpack remote antenna mounts (P/N 90209223-1 and P/N 90209223-2) (Figure 1).

#### NOTE

If hole exists in upper wire strike cutter approximately 4.94 inches down from top aft comer of cutter go to step (1) below. If no hole exists go to step (2) below.

- (1) Align center hole in template (PIN 90209223-3) with hole in cutter.
- (a) Secure template (P/N 90209223-3) to cutter with bolt (P/N AN3-7A), washer (P/N AN96OC10L) and nut (P/N NAS679A3W).
  - (b) Using template (P/N 90209223-3) as a guide, drill two pilot holes through cutter.
- (c) Remove bolt (P/N AN3-7A), washer (P/N AN96OC10L) and nut (P/N NAS679A3W) from template and cutter.
  - (d) Remove template.
  - (e) Ream out two holes in cutter to 0.204 inches.
  - (f) Clean and deburr holes.
  - (g) Go to step (3) below.
  - (2) Align template (P/N 90209223-3) with top edge of cutter.
    - (a) Using template (P/N 90209223-3) as a guide, drill three pilot holes through cutter
    - (b) Remove template.
    - (c) Ream out three holes In cutter to 0.204 inches.
    - (d) Clean and deburr holes.

(3) Surface treat antenna mount holes with Chemical Conversion Coating (MIL-C-81706).

Epoxy primer coating and Aliphatic Polyurethane Coating are flammable and toxic. They can irritate skin and cause bums. Use only in well ventilated area away from heat and open flame. Wear approved respirator, apron solvent resistant rubber gloves and chemical splash goggles. Thoroughly wash skin area with soap and water. Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. Get immediate medical attention for eyes.

- (4) Prime antenna mount holes with epoxy primer coating (MIL-P-23377).
- (5) Install antenna mounts (PIN 90209223-1 and P/N 90209223-2) on upper wire strike cover (Figure 1).
  - (a) Align mounts (PIN 90209223-1 and P/N 90209223-2) with previously drilled holes (Figure 1).
- (b) Secure mounts to cutter with three bolts (P/N AN3-7A), six washers (P/N AN960C10L) and three nuts (P/N NAS679A3W).
  - c. TrImpack Receiver Mount Installation Instructions (Figure 2).
- (1) Remove two existing screws from upper surface of instrument panel glareshield (Figure 2, view A-A). Retain screws.
  - (2) Position support adapter (P/N 902092249-1) on glare shield.
- (3) Secure support adapter to glareshield with two screws (P/N MS35206-229) and two washers (P/N AN960C6L) (Figure 2, view A-A).
- (4) Install Trimpack sleeve assembly (P/N 90209178-501) on lower support adapter (P/N 90209249-1) (Figure 2, view A-A).
- (5) Secure Trimpack sleeve assembly (P/N 90209178-501) to lower support adapter (P/N 90209249-1) with two screws (P/N MS35207-263) and two washers (P/N AN960C10L) (Figure 2, view A-A).
  - d. Aircraft electrical and antenna wiring instructions for Trimpack GPS.
    - (1) Remove existing clamps from windshield center post (Figure 2, Section B-B).
- (2) Position upper support adapter (P/N 90209249-501) on top of sleeve assembly (P/N 90209178-501) and align mounting holes.
  - (3) Transfer hole location from windshield center post to upper support adapter (P/N 90209249-501).
  - (4) Drill hole in upper support adapter (P/N 90209249-501).
  - (5) Clean and deburr hole.

(6) Surface treat hole with Chemical Conversion Coating (MIL-C-81706.

- (7) Prime hole with epoxy primer coating (MIL-P-23377).
- (8) Attach upper support adapter (P/N 90209249-501) to windshield center post with screw (P/N MS35207-271), two washers (P/N AN960C10L) nut (P/N NAS679A3W) spacer, (P/N NAS43DD3-12A) (Figure 2, Section B-B).
- (9) Secure upper support adapter (P/N 90209249501) to sleeve assembly (PIN 90209178-501) with four screws (P/N MS35207-263), eight washers (P/N AN960C10L) and four nuts (P/N NAS679A3W) (Figure 2, View A-A).
  - (10) Remove PROX WARN circuit breaker (if installed) In overhead console Stow wires
- (11) Install circuit breaker (P/N MS26574-1) In PROX WARN circuit breaker location In overhead console (Figure 3).
  - (12) Install GPS placard (P/N 90209223-5) on overhead console.
- (13) Starting at Trimpack mount, route power cable (P/N 90209183-504) forward and up left side of windshield center post along existing wire bundles to GPS circuit breaker (Figure 4, View B).
  - (14) Install terminal lug (P/N MS25036-102) on end of power cable (P/N 90209183-504).
  - (15) Install power cable (P/N 90209183-504) to load side of GPS circuit breaker (Figure 3, View A).
- (16) Install jumper assembly (P/N 90209223-6) from line side of ADF circuit breaker to line side of GPS circuit breaker (Figure 3, View A).
- (17) Starting at Trimpack mount route power cable ground wire forward along existing wire bundles behind main Instrument panel to local ground (Figure 4, View B).

- (18) Install terminal lug (P/N MS25036-103) on power cable ground wire.
- (19) Connect ground wire to local ground.
- (20) On upper exterior surface of cabin, locate first two rivets inboard of left upper wire strike cutter support.
  - (21) Position connector template (PIN 90209223-4) over first two rivets (Figure 5, View C).
  - (22) Drill pilot hole to locate RF bulkhead connector hole. Remove template.
  - (23) Ream pilot hole out to 0.500 inches.
  - (24) Clean and deburr hole.

(25) Surface treat hole with Chemical Conversion Coating (MIL-C-81706).

Wear approved respirator, apron solvent resistant rubber gloves and chemical splash goggles. Thoroughly wash skin area with soap and water. Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. - (26) Prime hole with epoxy primer coating (MIL-P-23377).
- (27) From inside cabin, install bulkhead lower antenna cable connector (P/N 90209182-507) with sealant (MIL-S-8802) in 0 500 inch hole (Figure 5, view C C).
  - (28) Secure cable connector with lockwasher and nut.
- (29) Continue routing antenna cable forward along existing wire bundles, down windshield center post to GPS Trimpack mount (Figure 4, view B).
  - (30) Secure antenna cable to existing wire bundles with tywraps (P/N MS3367-1-0).
- (31) On upper surface of cabin connect upper antenna cable (PIN 90209182-506) to bulkhead connector (Figure 5, View D).

- (32) Route cable up wire strike cutter to antenna mount (Figure 5, View D).
- (33) Connect upper antenna cable (P/N 90209182-506) to antenna blankoff panel connector (PIN 90209175501) (Figure 5, View D).
  - (34) Install antenna blankoff panel (PIN 90209175501) on GPS antenna mount (Figure 5, View D)
- (35) Secure blankoff panel to antenna mount with four screws (P/N MS35206-248) and four washers (P/N AN960C8L) (Figure 5, View D).
  - (36) Secure antenna cable to wire strike cutter support with tywraps (P/N MS3367-1-0) (Figure 5, View D).
  - (37) Install clamp (P/N MS21919WDG3) to lower mounting bolt on antenna mount (Figure 5, View D)
  - (38) Secure antenna cable to antenna mount with clamp (P/N MS21919WDG3) (Figure 5, View D)

#### e. Final procedures

- (1) Perform continuity check on coax cable for Trimpack remote antenna.
- (2) Close access to overhead console circuit breakers and wiring.
- (3) Install overhead cabin sound proofing blanket.
- (4) Connect aircraft battery.
- (5) Apply aircraft power to provide 28 VDC to GPS circuit breaker.
- (6) Verify pin B of GPS five pin audio connector is common with airframe ground.
- (7) Verify that pin D has 28VDC (Figure 6).

#### 10. KIT B INSTALLATION PROCEDURES.

- a. Remove GPS antenna Blankoff panel (if Installed) from GPS antenna mount (Figure 5, view D)
- b. Connect GPS upper antenna cable to connector on GPS antenna (P/N 1203800 or 16248-40)
- c. Install GPS antenna on mount (Figure 6).
- d. Secure with four screws (P/N MS35206248) and four washer (P/N AN960C8L) (Figure 5)

#### **NOTE**

Only Trimble Trimpack GPS receiver P/N's 16768-10 and 1676820 are allowed for this installation. These receivers have software that compensates for the effects of rotor modulation and have green lighting. All other Trimble Trimpack receivers cannot be used The P/N is located on a nameplate located between the receiver and battery pack. The battery pack must be moved to see the name plate An ANVIS (Aviator's Night Vision Imaging System) filter modification kit (NSN 5895-01- 340-5502) has been developed and when used with either GPS receiver will provide an ANVIS acceptable display. Installation instructions for this ANVIS filter modification are contained In document, ILS 91-ANV 0002, dated March 1991 provided with the ANVIS kit.

- e. Remove caps from GPS Trimpack receiver power connector and external antenna cable connector. Tape caps to side of receiver with tape (PPP-T-42) to prevent chafing
  - f. Install GPS Trimpack receiver in mount and secure with clamp assemblies (Figure 6).
  - g. Connect power and antenna cables to receiver (Figure 6).

#### 11. GPS CHECKOUT PROCEDURES.

- Move aircraft to ramp area with good satellite visibility.
- b. Apply aircraft power.
- c. Apply power to Trimpack. Check that it acquires satellites visible at time of test If GPS powers up and acquires satellites check is complete.

#### **NOTE**

If Trimpack receiver is removed from aircraft and operated on internal batteries external power connector cap must be installed.

- If GPS does not power up and aircraft power is present.
  - (1) Check GPS circuit breaker in.
  - (2) Check power connections to Trimpack receiver.
  - (3) Check power cable routing and connection to circuit breaker.
- e. If GPS does not acquire satellites.
  - (1) Check antenna cable connection to Trimpack receiver.
  - (2) Check antenna cable connection to bulkhead connector.
  - (3) Check antenna cable connection to GPS antenna.
  - (4) Recheck antenna installation.
- f. Aircraft power off.

#### 12. KIT B REMOVAL PROCEDURES.

- a. Remove GPS antenna from mount.
- b. Disconnect GPS antenna cable.
- c. Connect GPS antenna cable to Blankoff panel (PIN 90209175501).
- d. Install antenna Blankoff panel (P/N 90209175-501) on GPS antenna mount with four screws (P/N MS35206248) and washers (P/N AN960C8L) (Figure 5).
  - e. Remove Trimpack receiver from mount.

- f. Disconnect antenna and power cables.
- g. Install caps on Trimpack connectors.

#### 13. KIT A REMOVAL PROCEDURES.

- a. Prepare aircraft for safe ground maintenance (TM 55-1520-22823).
- b. Lower overhead console circuit breaker panel for access to power distribution wiring.
- c. Remove upper cabin sound proofing blanket as required to gain access to wire bundles and GPS antenna cable routing.
- d. Remove antenna blankoff panel (PIN 90209175-501) from GPS antenna mount by removing four screws (PIN MS35206-248) and four washers (PIN AN960C8L) (Figure 5, View D).
  - e. Disconnect GPS antenna from antenna blankoff connector.
- f. Remove Trimpack remote antenna mounts (PIN 90209223-1 and P/N 902092232) from upper wire strike cutter.
  - g. Remove GPS Trimpack upper support adapter (PIN 90209249-501) (figure 2).
  - h. Remove GPS Trimpack sleeve assembly (PIN 90209178501) (figure 2).
  - i. Remove GPS Trimpack lower support adapter (PIN 90209249-1) (figure 2).
  - j. Install two screws In center upper surface of glareshield.
  - k. Install clamp In windshield center post with shorter screw (Figure 2, Section B-B).
- I. Remove jumper wire (P/N 90209223-6) from line side of ADF circuit breaker and line side of GPS circuit breaker (Figure 3, View A).
  - m. Remove GPS power wire from GPS circuit breaker.
  - n. Remove circuit breaker (PIN MS26574-1) from overhead console (Figure 3).
  - o. Remove GPS circuit breaker (P/N MS265741) placard from overhead console (Figure 3).
  - p. Disconnect GPS power cable ground terminal from ground behind main instrument panel.
  - q. Remove GPS power cable.
- r. Remove upper antenna cable (PIN 90209182-506) from bulkhead connector (P/N 90209182-507) on exterior surface of cabin.
  - s. Remove bulkhead connector end of lower antenna cable (PIN 90209182-507) from upper cabin structure.
  - t. Remove upper antenna cable.
  - u. Remove lower antenna cable.

- v. Patch/repair antenna cable hole in upper cabin structure (TM 1-1500-20423).
- w. Close access to overhead console circuit breakers and wiring.
- x. Install overhead cabin sound proofing blanket.




Figure 1. GPS Antenna Mount Installation.




Figure 2. GPS Trimpack Receiver Mount Installation.




Figure 3. GPS Power Cable and Circuit breaker Installation




Figure 4. GPS Power Cable and Antenna Cable Installation.




Figure 5. GPS Antenna Cable Installation.




Figure 6. GPS Antenna and Trimpack Receiver Installation.




Figure 7. GPS Wiring Diagram.




Figure 8. Trimpack Sleeve Modification.
