- a. Aircraft in Use. Upon receipt of this Technical Bulletin (TB) the condition status symbol of the UH/ EH-60A aircraft will be changed to a red horizontal dash //-//. The red horizontal dash //-// entry shall state, "Records inspection required in accordance with TB 1-2840-248-20-22 engine records inspection." The red horizontal dash //-// may be cleared when the inspection of paragraph 8 below is completed. The UH/EH-60A aircraft engine records shall be inspected as soon as practical but no later than the inspection suspense date. Failure to comply with the requirements of this TB within the time frame will cause the status symbol to be upgraded to a red //X//. While the aircraft is on a red horizontal dash //-//, it may be reported as fully mission capable (FMC).
 - b. Aircraft in Depot Maintenance. Aircraft will not be issued until compliance with this TB has been completed.
 - c. Aircraft Undergoing Maintenance. Aircraft will not be released until compliance with this TB has been completed.
 - d. Aircraft in Transit.

An Integrated product team (IPT) formed by the Utility Helicopters' Project Management Office is currently reviewing the GEAE recommendations The IPT is assessing Impact on aviation customers for possible implementation of the proposed life reductions. Implementation is expected to occur In the March 1999 time frame.
