PART I--PUBLICATIONS

Section A--Functional (F) and Limited (L) Requirement

1. How To Submit Requirements. Customers will submit requirements to their PDOs; PDOs will consolidate requirements and forward to **Air Force Publishing Distribution Center (AFPDC) to arrive NLT 2 October 1998.** Superseded publications remain current until those listed below are published: **New Publications Not Previously Announced.** CARs and PDOs must submit requirements: (Applicability to NGB or RE: In keeping with the total force policy, new publication policy dictates all departmental publications applicable to the active forces, Guard, and Reserve unless the functional statement and the publication specifically state that the entire publication or portions thereof, **DO NOT** apply.)

AFI33-133, Joint Technical Architecture. This Air Force Instruction (AFI) will mandate the use of the JTA-AF for all Air Force communications and information systems and the interfaces to their key assets (e.g., weapons systems, sensors). It will describe the roles and responsibilities, particularly of the program managers, for ensuring conformance with the JTA-AF or securing the appropriate waivers. The JTA-AF includes the following mandatory components: a) Standards - the standards component identifies standards, policies, services, protocols, and interfaces. b) Domains - the domain component identifies implementation details of the standards, policies, services, protocols and interfaces within the logical sub-division of the Air Force having similar functions, namely Fixed Base, Deployed, Airborne, and Space.) Recommended Products - recommended products are COTS products or product

suites specified in the JTA-AF for implementation in AF IT system. These products are compliant with the standards, policies, and guidance identified in the JTA-AF and the JTA. Distr: F. OPR: AFCA/XPX.

AFMAN65-609, Responsibility Center/Cost Center Codes. This publication will supersede DFAS-DER7000-1 (formally AFR170-5). This publication will be electronic only. OPR: SAF/FMBMM.

AFQTP3E1X1-21, AC and Refrigeration. Air Force Qualification Training Packages (AFQTPs) are developed to enhance on-the-job training for the HVAC/REFRIGERATION personnel. It provides the trainer, the breakdown of tasks into teachable elements. They will help the trainer guide the trainee toward gaining enough proficiency to do the tasks.
