

(Patrol Mission Order Extract)

**Company B, 2-123 IN
Camp Rifle, Iraq
091000 Aug 20XX**

1. SITUATION:

a. Enemy forces. Local insurgent cells and individuals continue to be active in Kitra City. Insurgents are capable of employing explosive devices, rocket propelled grenades, and small arms fire to attack, harass and interdict coalition forces and local government officials operating in the area.

b. Friendly forces. U.S. forces occupying Camp Rifle are responsible for maintaining a military presence within the Nusom district which includes Kitra City. The forces conduct civil-military reconstruction operations, humanitarian missions, and train local police officers. Nusom National Guard soldiers and local police are present in the city. Battalion QRF and MEDEVAC are on call. EOD support available on call.

2. MISSION: Elements of 3rd Platoon, Company B, 2-123 Infantry conduct presence patrol on Route Black, Kitra City, (see map) commencing 091400 Aug 20XX to maintain visible military presence in the city and coordinate with designated local officials as required.

3. EXECUTION:

a. Concept of Operation. Patrol departs Rifle at 1350 hrs to cross at SP at 1400 hrs. The patrol will use 4 armored HMMWVs in column with 50 meter interval. March speed will be 25 km/hr except for congested areas. Follow designated route with scheduled halt, render reports to battalion TOC per SOP and re-enter Camp Rifle NLT 091900 hrs.

b. Team 1 (vehicles Bravo 1 and Bravo 2) leads patrol. Lead vehicle will have MK19 mounted.

c. Team 2 (vehicles Bravo 3 and Bravo 4) follow and support Team 1. Lead vehicle will have .50 cal machine gun mounted.

d. Coordinating Instructions. Report PCC complete per battalion SOP NLT 1300 radio check. ROE and ROI are per battalion SOP. Actions on contact per battalion SOP. Do not engage unless you can positively identify enemy position. Scheduled halt will be vicinity City Park at the midpoint of the route. All elements maintain continuous air and ground surveillance and report unusual activity. Notify battalion TOC on Fox 3 net of any support requirements. All members attend debrief/after action review after return to base.

4. SERVICE SUPPORT: Vehicle and individual combat load per battalion SOP. Medical support on call at Rifle. Disabled vehicle recovery support per battalion SOP.

5. COMMAND AND SIGNAL:

- a. Command. Patrol Leader will be with Team 1. Assistant Patrol Leader will be with Team 2. APL assumes command if PL is disabled.
- b. Signal. Use FM secure voice on company Fox 1 net. Current SOI in effect.
- c. Running password is PUMPKIN PIE.
