GENERAL INVESTIGATIONS REPROGRAMMINGS

Reprogramming Limits for District and Division Commanders 1/

Groupings for Reprogramming Purposes	Individual Study, Project or Activity Reprogramming Limits
Individual Surveys or Preconstruction, Engineering and Design Projects (Subclass codes 110-165, and categories 400 and 600)	Up to \$25,000 when the base is \$25,000 or less, 100% of the base over \$25,000 up to \$50,000 when the base exceeds \$25,000 plus 25% of the base over \$50,000 to a maximum of \$150,000. 2/
Each subclass within classes 170 and 180 (Coordination Studies with Other Agencies) constitutes a separate group for reprogramming purposes.	Unlimited within each group. 3/
International Water Studies (Category/class/subclass (CCS) 240)	Unlimited.
Floodplain Management Services (CCS 250)	Unlimited to FPMS Units; Technical Services; Guides, Pamphlets, and Supporting Studies; and Special Studies. \$10,000 maximum from any single FPMS item. 4/
Hydrologic Studies (CCS 260)	Unlimited.

1/ In accordance with applicable general guidance in paragraphs 6a and b and specific limitations on District and MSC Commander authorities in 6c(1).

2/ Reconnaissance study schedules may not be extended by reprogramming, nor should reprogramming be used to exceed the reconnaissance study cost limit of 25% of total study cost set forth in Paragraph 1.6.f. of ER 1105-2-10.

3/ There is no authority to either increase or decrease work allowances provided for cost shared studies under the Planning Assistance to States program (CCS 186), and the statutory ceiling of \$300,000 annually for any one State is not to be exceeded.

4/ There is no authority to increase work allowances provided for quick responses.
