CONSTRUCTION, GENERAL REPROGRAMMINGS

Reprogramming Limits for District and Division Commanders 1/

Groupings for Reprogramming Purposes	Individual Project or Activity Reprogramming Limits
Individually budgeted Construction, Dam Safety, Rehabilitation, Rectification, and Modification Projects.	Up to \$300,000 for projects with a base less than \$2,000,000; 15% for projects with a base of more than \$2,000,000; and up to \$5,000,000 for settled contractor claims, accelerated contractor earnings or real estate deficiency judgments.
Continuing Authorities and Sections 1135 and 204 projects: Each subclass constitutes a separate group for reprogramming purposes (i.e., work allowance may not be reprogrammed among projects carried out under different authorities).	Up to \$15,000 regardless of the base or 15% of base up to a maximum of \$50,000, whichever is larger. <u>2/ 3/</u> Work allowances to support coordination with local interests may not be increased or decreased.
Aquatic Plant Control	\$5,000.

1/ In accordance with applicable general guidance in paragraphs 6a and b and specific limitations on District and MSC Commander authorities in 6c(1).

2/ The gaining project must have received an initial work allowance from CECW-PM in the current or the prior fiscal year and new phases may not be initiated by reprogramming, however funds may be reprogrammed among projects in different phases.

3/ Reprogramming for work done under Section 1135 or Section 204 authority must be consistent with percentage of total cost restrictions on feasibility phase, and plans and specifications. Statutory ceiling on Federal cost for project may not be exceeded.
