## CHAPTER 8 - ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE TRAINING REQUIRED BY STATUTE AND IMPLEMENTING REGULATIONS

- 8-1. <u>Purpose</u>. This chapter establishes the policy for training requirements for personnel affected by certain statutes and implementing regulations concerning environmental compliance.
- 8-2. <u>Applicability</u>. This chapter applies to all USACE commands having responsibilities for civil works functions, including floating plant. USACE military-funded facilities and activities will adapt the training guidance in AR 200-1, Environmental Protection and Enhancement, in coordination with CECW-OA.
- 8-3. <u>Policy</u>. USACE commanders will promote environmental compliance and avoid regulatory agency fines and penalties by providing environmental training required by applicable Federal and state statutes and implementing regulations to applicable USACE employees. Information regarding training required by several Federal environmental statutes and regulations can be obtained from Environmental Compliance Coordinators.
