Flashing **GREEN**

lights indicate your unit is NOT in secure mode. AMBER (ACCESS)lights should be on. If not, investigate. Push ACK switch DOWN to change to secure mode. Steady **GREEN** lights indicate your unit IS in secure mode.

Flashing AMBER -

lights indicate the control unit operator is in secured area and has switched to ACCESS or TEST/RESET with his or her key. Push ACK switch DOWN to acknowledge access mode (steady AMBER).

Flashing WMITE

lights and audible alarm indicate your monitor unit's power supply has changed from AC to battery. Acknowledge by pushing switch DOWN. DO NOT reset until AC power returns. To clear, push switch UP.

Flashing WMITE

lights and audible alarm indicate control unit has lost AC power and is operating on battery. Report condition to maintenance. See paragraph above on clearing steps.

A If lamps are burning steady or flashing, a lamp check is NOT needed. If not burning, perform steps B and C.

Push switch UP.

If white (MONITOR AC POWER) lights do not flash call maintenance.

Push switch DOWN.

Call maintenance if any bulb on module fails to burn.

ACK NOT PLE DOE Alarm Condition

Flashing **RED** lights and audible alarm indicate the control unit has sensed an alarm.

Push switch DOWN to ACK. This silences alarm and changes lights from flashing to steady.

Notify investigative forces.

DO NOT clear a signal on your unit until cause of alarm has been eliminated.

To clear, plush switch UP to RESET after control unit has been cleared. (For control units set in NON-LATCH position, you can reset without control unit being cleared. If in LATCH position, control unit operator must RESET his or her unit before you can clear your monitor.) RED lights go off when cleared.


