# Information to Know

## Prerequisites

Prerequisites for each NCOES course are listed in AR 351-1. An order of merit list will be established at battalion level or equivalent level for all courses. To be placed on the order of merit list a soldier must have:

- 1. Passed the APFT within the past 6 months IAW FM 21-20
- 2. Met the Physical Fitness and Weight standards IAW 600-9 and AR 350-41

### **Profiles**

Soldiers with temporary profiles that prevent them from performing all the duties of their PMOS and Skill level listed in AR 611-201, chapter 2 and appendix B, will be deferred from attendance at the course until the temporary profile is removed. <u>Soldiers that fall in this category should not be sent to the course</u>.

Soldiers with permanent profiles that prevent them from performing all the duties of their PMOS and Skill level listed in AR 611-201, chapter 2 and appendix B, must be processed under AR 600-60. Attendance at the course will be deferred until this process is completed. Soldiers that fall in this category should not be sent to the course. Once approval is granted for retention in PMOS by the MOS Medical Review Board (MMRB) or Disability Board or for reclassification, the soldier will be authorized to attend the course and will be required to participate in training up to the limits of the profile. The soldier will be required to present results of the MMRB/Disability Board proceedings during in-processing.

### <u>Time Left in Service</u>

In accordance with AR 351-1, chapter 5, active component soldiers must have 6 months or more remaining in service upon completion of a NCOES course. <u>Soldiers that do not fall in this category should not be sent to the course</u>. If a soldier needs to re-enlist, please make sure this is done prior to reporting to the course.

### **Reporting Procedures**

Students reporting to the course must report NLT 0430 on the reporting date. On the day of report, the uniform is the PT uniform with their ID Card. Students reporting after 0430 will be returned to their units.

Students from installations other than Fort Benning are encouraged to report after 1330 the day prior to the class start date. <u>Please do not reports earlier than this</u>.

# In-Processing Location

In-processing will take place at the PLDC Barracks located in Building 2760A.

## Items Required for In-Processing

The following items are required for in-processing (<u>Students reporting without all of the required items will be returned to their units</u>):

- 1. Copy of DA form 2 and 2A
- 2. Individual health records
- 3. Copy of TABE Test results
- 4. (Reserve Component Only) Finance Records
- 5. Meal Card All students will be removed from separate rations; they are required to eat in the Dining Facility. The parent units will issue meal cards (with the exception of Reserve Component soldiers). Reserve Component soldiers will be issued meal cards by the academy's S1. Feeder reports will be sent to the NCOA.

### **Required Forms/Orders**

- 1. (3) copies of the Commander's Checklist
- 2. (3) copies of DD Form 1610
- 3. Fort Benning soldiers only (3) copies of the memorandum orders, (3) copies of the Commander's Checklist and (3) copies of FB form 5-R.
- 4. All items of required clothing/equipment as listed for the appropriate course attendance.
- 5. Original DA Form 705 (soldier must have been tested within 6 months prior to the class start date).
- 6. DD Form 2A
- 7. Identification tags with required chains

### <u>POVs</u>

In accordance with USAIC Reg 190-5, all TDY students remaining at Fort Benning, Georgia for a period of 2 weeks or more must have at a minimum the following liability/no fault insurance:

- 1. Liability:
  - (a). \$10,000 per individual
  - (b). \$20,000 per accident
  - (c). \$5,000 property damage

2. No Fault: \$5,000 per insured

Students reporting to the Primary Leadership Development Course without the minimum amount of POV insurance will be required to turn in their POV keys to the Branch Chief until graduation or proof of insurance is provided.
