The **red horizontaldash** //-// may be cleared when the inspection of paragraph 8 below is completed. The affected aircraft shall be inspected as soon as practical but no later than 8 February 2000. Failure to comply with the requirements of this TB within the time frame will cause the status symbol to be upgraded to a **red** b.

- a. It has **been** found through-the **deficiency reporting system that a** generator powar-cable chafed and **caused** a fire on an AH-64A aircraft.
 - b. For manpower/downtime and funding impacts, see paragraph 12.
- c. The purpose of this TB is to direct a one-time inspection of the suspect area for chafing and provide corrective action.
- 5. End Items to be inspected. All AH-64A aircraft.

- 8.' Inspection Procedures.
 - a. Locate wire bundle W668 (main power lines) from No. 2 generator.
- b. Inspect for adequate clearance and/or signs of chafing of this cable from the No. 2 generator through the main transmission bay area.
- c. Pay special attention to the area where the cable comes near the rotor blade de-ice controller (A311). If plug wire bundle (W118) clamp. This is the area along the main transmission deck near the base of the forward right hand main transmission mount, and is the point where a fire initiated on an AH-64A aircraft.
- d. A full inspection of other wire bundles in this congested location shall also be conducted to identify.

 any other problem areas.
- e. The aircraft maintenance manuals already include a general requirement to check for chafing wire on the aircraft.

- a. Repair wires which show evidence of damage/chafing IAW normal maintenance practices (reference paragraph 93). If no chafing is evident, but clearly in question, ensure cables are routed and clamped correctly.
 - b. Position, adjust, and clamp suspect cable(s) as necessary to ensure adequate clearance.
- c . Apply **anti-chafe** material (paragraph **10.c) to** all **inspected areas, regardless** if chafing is present, as a means to prevent-potential chafing.
