- **a. Aircraft in Use.** Upon receipt of the message/TB whichever occurs first, the condition status symbol of the cited aircraft will be changed to a **Horizontal Red** –. The **Horizontal Red** may be cleared when the inspection of paragraph 8 is completed. The affected aircraft shall be inspected as soon as practical but no later than the task/inspection suspense date.
