



Decrease the interval and lubricate more frequently if your lubricants have been contaminated or you are operating under adverse conditions, including longer -than -usual operating hours. The intervals between Lubrications maybe extended during periods of low activity, but only if adequate preser-

vation precautions have been taken. The lowest level 01 maintenance authorized to lubricate a point is indicated by one of the following symbols: Operator/Crew (C) and Organizational Maintenance (O). Clean all fittings, plugs, and caps before removal and/or lubrication. Remove all excess oil or grease after lubrication. If possible, exercise moving parts to distribute? Lubricant evenly. Lubricate all oil can points after washing or fording.

- 4. OIL CAN POINTS. In accordance with the intervals listed in this Lubrication Order, lubricate the Door Hinges and Latches, Step Hinges, Air Vent Hinge and Exhaust Fan Cover Hinge with OGP.
