

## NOTES.

1. DRIVE CHAINS Quarterly clean, coat sparingly with OE-10, and wipe oil from outer surface.

2. MOTOR BEARING RECESSES. Semiannually add GAA grease sparingly to seal out moisture

3. GEAR REDUCTION UNIT Every 5 days when unit is in continuous use (and after operation), check oil level and keep level up to center of gage. When use is less than once every 7 days semiannually check oil level and keep level up to center of gage. Annually drain oil, remove top of reduction unit, and refill with OE-30

4. LUBRICATE. Once every 5 days when unit is In continuous use (and after operation). Lubricate quarterly when use is less than once every 7 days.
