HEADSET ELECTRICAL H-251/U, FSN 5965-043-3460 FOR USE WITH RADAR SET AN/PPS-5

Headquarters, Department of the Army, Washington, D. C. 20315 23 February 1971

- 1. **Purpose and Scope.** This bulletin is to inform all users of Radar Sets AN/PPS-5 (plain model) of the requirement to requisition adapter cable, FSN 5995-485-7534, which will adapt the use of Headset, Electrical H-251/U with the Radar Sets.
- 2. **General.** *a.* Headsets H-226/PPS-5 and H-225A/PPS-5 were issued to the field with Radar Sets AN/PPS-5 (plain model). Standard Headset Electrical H-251/U, utilized with other equipment, was issued with Radar Set AN/PPS-5A.
- b. The two headsets are electrically hut not mechanically interchangeable. Headsets H-226/PPS-5 and H-226A/PPS-5 will be phased out of the system

since they are only compatible with Radar Set AN/PPS-5 (plain model).

- c. To prevent the continence of stocking two headsets in the supply system, all using organizations will requisition Headset, Electrical H-251/U, FSN 5965-043-3460, and adapter cable, FSN 5995-485-7534 when replacing Headsets H-226/PPS-5 FSN 5965-933-4473 and H-226A/PPS-5 FSN 5965-116-5363.
