

DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY SUPPLY BULLETIN

PESTICIDES

Headquarters, Department of the Army, Washington, DC
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1. Purpose

This bulletin furnishes guidance for units when requesting pesticides and for logistical activities when requisitioning these items.

2. Definitions

A pesticide is a substance or mixture of substances that may prevent, destroy, repel, or mitigate pests. The following types of pesticides are listed in this bulletin: insecticides, for use against insects and their near relatives; herbicides, for use against plant life; and rodenticides, for use against rodents and related animal pests. Insect repellents are insecticides which prevent biting or other annoyance by insects.

3. General Information

a. Pesticides listed in Appendix A will normally be utilized at Department of Army (DA) installations and for troop unit supply. Only items assigned a National Stock Number (NSN) are included. Prior review and approval by Major Command (MACOM) professional pest management personnel in accordance with (IAW) Army Regulation (AR) 420-76 are required before acquiring or applying nonstandard pesticides. The installation pest management plan lists specific pest management control requirements and should be used in determining the types and amounts of pesticides to be maintained in inventory. Refer to SD-14, Listing of Toxic Chemicals, Hazardous Substances, and Ozone Depleting Chemicals, and substitute, when possible, with products not listed under the above standard. Pesticide needs should be projected on an annual basis with the supply on-hand limited to quantities for 90 days of operation. The need for these items may vary seasonally and within geographic subdivisions of commands. MACOMs may issue directives authorizing requisitions IAW requirements. (The guidance provided in this subparagraph does not apply to veterinary activities or the pesticides listed in Appendix A, table A-10, of this bulletin.)

b. This supply bulletin is not intended to authorize pesticide items to be maintained in Table of Organization and Equipment (TOE) unit basic loads. Common Table of Allowances (CTA) 50-970 lists pesticide allowances for such units. MACOMs will designate the stockage level of basic loads for TOE units IAW AR 710-2, para 2-11.

c. Government contractors may elect to mark pesticide containers with an expiration date that indicates their

contract warranty period. Such expiration dates shall be ignored by pesticide users and will not serve as a basis for declaring the pesticides unserviceable. DLA stored pesticides undergo periodic quality assurance testing as indicated by shelf life codes. Based on these tests, DLA will either extend the shelf life or remove the product from the supply system. Therefore, except for quality deficiencies, pesticides should be used as specified on the label. Unsatisfactory pesticides (e.g. failure to emulsify, inadequate label) must be reported on SF 368 (Quality Deficiency Report) to Commander, ATCOM, ATTN: AMSAT-I-MDO, 4300 Goodfellow Blvd, St. Louis, MO 63120-1798 IAW DA Pam 738-750, para 12-2.

d. A guide to frequently used pesticide trademarks and the corresponding common names used in this bulletin is provided in appendix B. Pesticides listed herein are cross-referenced by NSN in appendix C.

4. Explanation of Terms

a. *Unit of Issue (UI) Code.* A UI Code is a two character alphabetic code which expresses a definite amount or quantity of an item that will be issued. This is the unit upon which price is based, accountable records are maintained, and requirements are computed.

b. *Acquisition Advice Code (AAC).* An AAC is a one-character alphabetic code which indicates to the requisitioner how and under what restrictions an item will be acquired. The following codes apply: D-DOD Integrated Materiel Manager, Stocked and Issued. G-GSA Integrated Materiel Manager, Stocked and Issued. H-Direct Delivery under a Central Contract, non stocked items. I-Direct Ordering from a Central Contract/Schedule, non stocked items. J-Not Stocked, Centrally Procured non stocked items. L-Local Purchase, non stocked items. V-Terminal Item. Z-Insurance/Numeric Stockage Objective Item

c. *Source of Supply (SOS) Code.* A SOS Code is a three-character alphanumeric code which identifies the activity to which requisitions are to be directed (Routing Identifier Code). Alternatively, a three-character alphabetic SOS Modifier Code (first position "J") is used to denote routing information for requisitions which cannot be addressed to a single routing identifier or when a single routing identifier cannot be assigned.
