A. JDA REMAINS OPTIMISTIC THAT NEW DEFENSE TECHNOLOGY POLICY CAN BE IN PLACE, HOPEFULLY BEFORE DIET ADJOURNS AND WELL BEFORE ITO'S VISIT TO WASHINGTON. AS DISCUSSED IN THE EMBASSY'S MESSAGE, THE PRIME MINISTER HAS PROVIDED "GUIDANCE" TO THE CABINET, AND MOFA NOW HAS BEEN TASKED TO SOUND OUT THE U.S. SIDE. BASED ON THE U.S. PEACTION AND SUBSEQUENT INTERNAL GOJ DISCUSSIONS, JDA HOPES FOR A DECISION.

- B. JDA BELIEVES THAT FOLLOWING THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE NEW POLICY, THERE WILL STILL BE A NEED TO MOVE QUICKLY TO ACHIEVE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. ON A NUMBER OF TECHNICAL AND PRACTICAL ISSUES RELATING TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW POLICY. THESE INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO, SUCH QUESTIONS AS THE KINDS OF AGREEMENTS OR "MOU'S" NEEDED TO PERMIT COOPERATIVE RED, WHETHER SUCH MOU'S SHOULD BE NARROW OR BROAD IN SCOPE, AND WHETHER WE CAN DEFINE THE KINDS OF INITIAL PROJECTS THE TWO SIDES HAVE IN MIND.
- C. JDA WOULD LIKE TO USE MINISTER ITO'S VISIT AS AN OCCASION FOR FORMALLY ENDORSING THE NEW PROPOSED TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER ARRANGEMENTS. JDA OFFICIALS DO NOT BELIEVE, HOWEVER, THAT THE ITO VISIT WOULD BE THE APPROPRIATE TIME TO SETTLE TECHNICAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES. FURTHERMOPE, TO THE EXTENT THAT SUCH ISSUES REMAIN UNRESOLVED BY THE TIME OF THAT VISIT, SUCH ISSUES APE LIKELY TO DETRACT FROM THE OVERALL BPOAD FOREIGN POLICY AND NATIONAL SECURITY QUESTIONS THAT SHOULD BE THE FOCUS OF SUCH DISCUSSIONS.

  D. FINALLY, WE SENSE THAT MANY IN THE GOJ FEAR THAT IF SOME OF THESE TECHNICAL OUESTIONS ARE LEFT FOR RESOLUTION UNTIL DECEMBER, THEY ARE LIKELY TO BECOME ENTWINED WITH THE UPCOMING LDP ELECTIONS AND ANY SUBSEQUENT CABINET RESHUFFLE. JDA FEARS THAT A USEFUL WINDOW FOR MOVING THE POLICY FORWARD WILL BE LOST AND THAT IT WILL HAVE TO BEGIN AGAIN FROM SCRATCF WITH A WHOLE NEW SET OF CABINET OFFICIALS EAPLY NEXT YEAR. JDA WOULD RATHER POSTPONE THE NEXT SETF AND HAVE A PRIVATE MEETING, RATHER THAN HAVE NO MEETING AT ALL.
- 4. (U) AS WE UNDERSTAND IT FROM HERE, JDA IS POSING TWO SPECIFIC REQUESTS WITH REGARD TO TIMING:
- A. CAN THE VISIT OF THE DOD PLANNING GROUP POSSIBLY BE ACCELERATED SO THAT IT COULD COME TO TOKYO AS EARLY AS THE END OF THIS MONTH. POSSIBLY BEFORE SSC?
- E. ASSUMING THAT THE NEW DUSD/IPT WILL NOT BE APPOINTED AND THERE CANNOT BE FORMAL SETF BEFORE ITO'S VISIT TO WASHINGTON, IS THERE ANY PERIOD BETWEEN NOW AND THAT VISIT (I.E. EARLY SEPTEMBER?) WHEN USDRE CAN AND IS WILLING TO MEET WITH KINOSHITA IN WASHINGTON TO HAVE THE HIGH LEVEL DIALOGUE NECESSARY FOR SETTING THE STAGE FOR THE ITO VISIT?
- 5. (U) WHILE MDO HAS INDICATED IT WOULD PASS JDA'S REQUESTS ON TO WASHINGTON, WE ASSUME A PPIVATE VISIT BY KINOSHITA (EVEN IF THE TIMING CAN BE WORKED OUT) IS NOT AN ACCEPTABLE SUBSTITUTION TO A CAREFULLY PREPAPED SATF. WE HAVE THEREFORE TOLD JDA (MURAI) THAT THERE IS LITTLE TIME TO PREPARE FOR AN EARLY FALL MEETING (ESPECIALLY AN SATE) AND IN ANY CASE, USG CANNOT BEGIN TO MAKE PLANS UNTIL THE GOJ FINALLY ACTS ON ITS NEW POLICY.
