DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a vehicle headlight in a first state in a sequence of a front view of a vehicle with illuminable light sequence showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged view of the called out portion of FIG.

FIG. 8 is an enlarged view of the called out portion of FIG.


FIG. 9 is a fifth state thereof; and,

The elements shown outside the broken lines form no part of the claimed design and are merely included to show environmental aspects thereof.

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


















