## IMPROVEMENT IN PAPER BOXES.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. **189,037**, dated April 3, 1877; application filed  
January 24, 1877.

*To all whom it may concern.*

Be it known that I, LORENZO P. HEATH, of Springfield, in the county of Hampden and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new and useful Improvement in Paper Boxes, which improvement is fully set forth in the following specification and accompanying drawing, in which—

A is the main box; B, a vertically-lifting cover; D, an auxiliary box, constructed on the top of cover B; and E, an ordinary swinging cover, hinged on one side of box D.

This box is one of the kind known as "peterie"-boxes; and the object of my invention is to provide, by auxiliary box D and cover E, a suitable and additional receptacle for fancy paper, valentines, or other articles,

while the main box A is devoted to the keeping of other descriptions of paper or envelopes.

Auxiliary box D is constructed by attaching the side strips *eeee* to the top of cover B, the top of the latter forming the bottom of box D.

What I claim as my invention is—

The combination of the auxiliary box D, the hinged cover E, and the vertically-lifting cover B, with the main box A, substantially as and for the purpose set forth.
