IMPROVEMENT IN HOG-CHOLERA COMPOUNDS.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 205,364, dated June 25, 1878; application filed September 4, 1877.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Andrew R. Derrickson, of Bedford, county of Taylor, and State of Iowa, have invented a new and useful Medical Compound for the Diseases of Hogs, which compound is fully described in the following specification.

This invention relates to that class of medical compounds intended for curing hog-cholera; and it consists in a composition formed by mixing the ingredients hereinafter fully described.

To prepare the compound, I take one pint of flaxseed-oil, one-half pint of tar, one ounce oil of asafetida, four ounces of tobacco, one dram of oil of origanum, one dram of aqua ammonia, one dram tincture of aconite-root, one dram tincture of opii, one dram of oilve-oil, one dram of chloroform, one dram of oil of sassafras, and one dram of oil of cloves.

The above ingredients are thoroughly mixed together, when it is ready for use, and is to be given by drenching the hog with a half-pint of the mixture.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The herein-described medical compound, consisting of flaxseed-oil, tar, asafetida, to-bacco, origanum, aqua ammonia, aconite, opii, olive-oil, chloroform, oil of sassafras, and oil of cloves, mixed in the proportions substantially as specified.
