

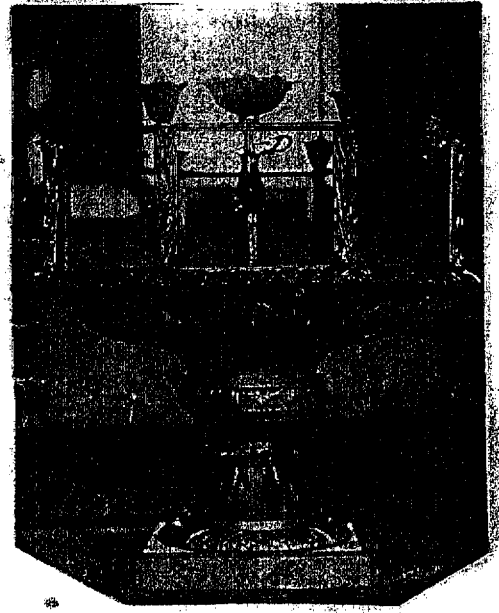

DESIGN FOR AQUARIUMS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,059**, dated February 16, 1875; application filed January 18, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

CASE B.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH W. FISKE, of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented certain Improvements in Design for Aquarium, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration.

A represents an ornamental base or support, on which is mounted an ornamental bowl, B, on which is formed an octagonal vessel, C, composed of panes of glass held in a frame

composed of ornamental uprights connected by a top rail. From the center of the vessel rises a small column or pipe, D, which supports a small bowl and terminates with a jet, through which water may be forced to produce a miniature fountain.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for an aquarium, as herein shown and described.
