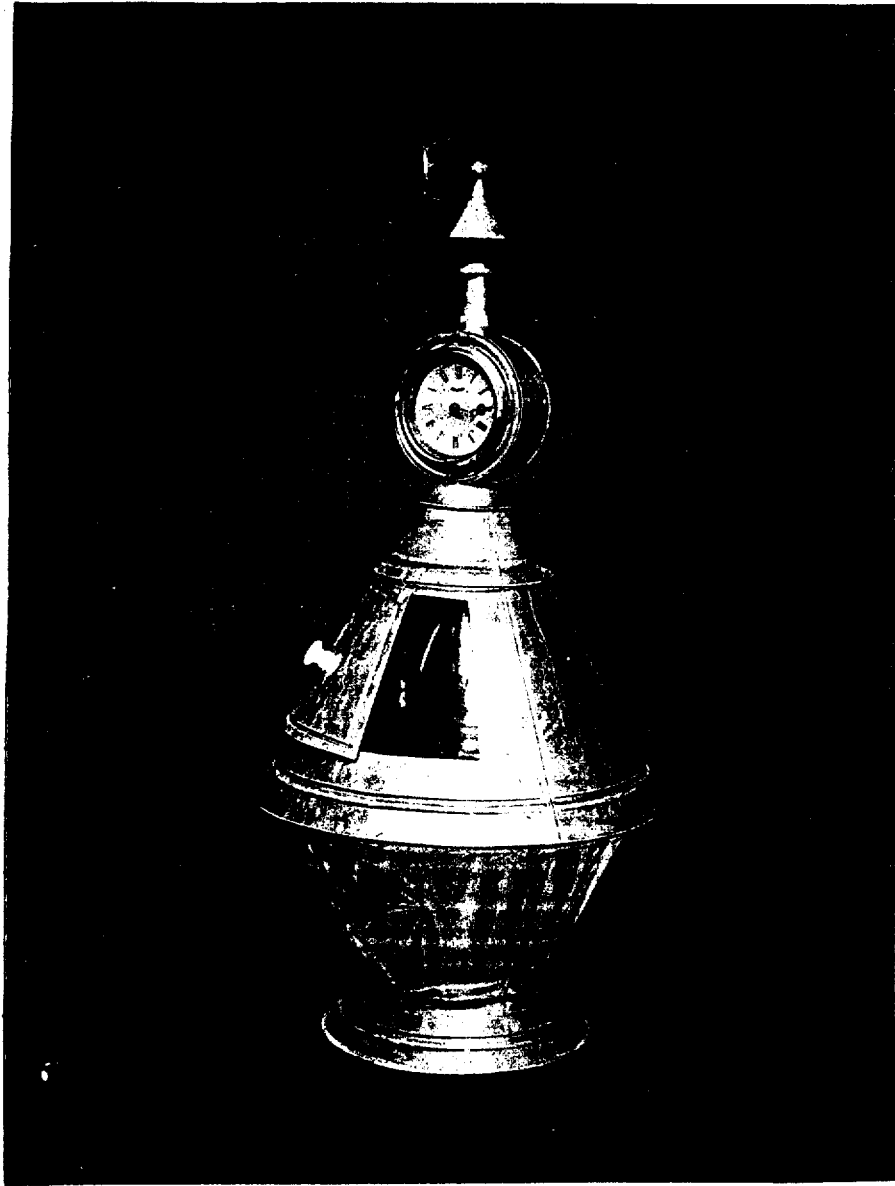

## DESIGN FOR SPICE-CAN.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,063**, dated February 16, 1875; application filed December 11, 1874.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ZACHARIAH R. TRAVER, of Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a Design for a Spice-Can, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

A represents a sheet-metal can, having the form of two truncated cones joined at their bases, with an opening in the upper cone, which is provided with a door, A'. The can rests upon a movable base, and is surmounted by a marine clock, B, which, in turn, is surmounted by a final ornament, a.

The can is intended to be placed on a grocer's counter, to contain mustard or ground spices in bulk, from which they are conveniently dispensed, while the clock serves to attract the attention of customers to the can.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a spice-can, A, composed of two cones joined at their bases, the upper one having a door, A', and surmounted by a clock, B, and final ornament, a, substantially as represented and described.
