

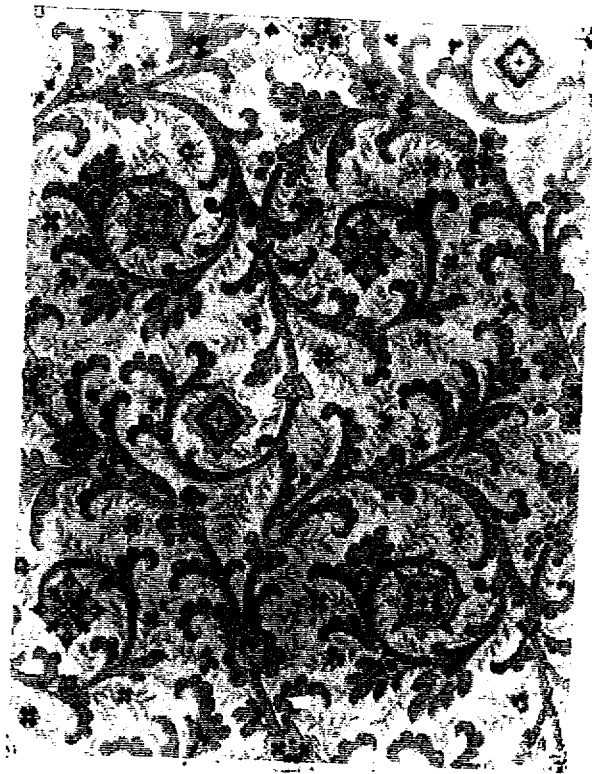

DESIGN FOR CARPETS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,112**, dated February 23, 1875; application filed February 9, 1875.
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY HORAN, of East Orange, Essex county, New Jersey, have invented or produced a new and original Design for a Pattern to be Inwrought into In-grain and other Carpeting, in colors similar to those painted on the drawings or photographs accompanying this specification, or in other colors substituted in the place of those painted on the drawings or photographs herewith; and I do hereby declare that the drawings accompanying this specification do give and convey to any one skilled in the art of carpet-weaving a defined and thorough description of the

nature of my invention, and are sufficient to enable any one skilled in the art of carpet-weaving to use my invention.
