

DESIGN FOR SHOW-CARDS FOR EXHIBITING VEST-BUTTONS.

Specification f. rming part of Design No. 8,180, dated March 2, 1875; application filed February 16, 1875. [Term of Patent 31 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Julius Fuld, of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Design for Show-Cards; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, which will enable others skilled in the art to which it pertains to make and use the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings and to the letters of reference marked thereon, which form a part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully illustrated in the accompanying drawing; and it consists in a show-eard for exhibiting vest-buttons, having the representation of a vest thereon, with the buttons fastened thereon in their

proper places.

In the drawing, A represents a show-card

of any suitable dimensions, upon which is formed the representation B of a vest. C C represent vest-buttons, which are fastened on the vest representation B in their proper

This enables the purchaser to see how the buttons will look on the vest, and will be of great service to the trade.

What I claim is—

The design for show-card for exhibiting vest-buttons, consisting of the representation of a vest, with the buttons fastened thereon in their proper places, as shown and described.
