DESIGN FOR MATCH-SAFE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,195, dated March 9, 1875; application filed February 26, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

CASE A.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OTTO F. FOGELSTRAND, of Kensington, in the county of Hartford and State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Match-Safe, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying engraving, to which reference is made.

The match-receptacle is formed in the base A, which is four-sided and flaring, the two ends being rounded, as shown. The lid B is of the same form, and is provided with a raised handle or knob, C, the sides of which are fluted and the top provided with raised ornamental work, as shown. The edge of the lid B is vertical at its base, the same forming a

plain band, above which is a cove; then follows a flaring band having sunken ornaments thereon, and reaching to the top surface of the lid, said surface being ornamented in relief. Portions of the base are cut away, but left at the corners, to form legs, as shown. The flaring sides are provided with ornamental openwork.

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for a match-safe, in which the device is composed of the parts A, B, and C, ornamented substantially in the manner above described.
