

DESIGN FOR MATCH-SAFE.

Specification ferming part of Design No. 8,196, dated March 9, 1875; application filed February 26, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

CASE B.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OTTO F. FOGELSTRAND, of Kensington, in the county of Hartford and State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Match-Safe, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying engraving, to which reference is made.

A represents the safe proper, or match-receptacle; B, its lid, and C the back. The back C extends both above and below the match-receptacle B, and is mostly of curved braces or open-work; but the lower portion has a solid bar, D, ending with three points at the bottom, and provided with a roughened sur-

face, as shown. The top surface of the lid B and the front of the receptacle C are ornamented by raised scroll-work, as shown, and the surface between the raised work and the raised border is roughened with fine checkwork, as shown.

What I claim as my invention is-

A design for a match-safe, in which the back C, receptacle A, and lid B are in the form shown, and ornamented in the manner shown and described.
