DESIGN FOR CARPETS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,197, dated March 9, 1875; application filed February 15, 1875.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented or produced a Design for a Carpet Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, the remainder of the design being merely a

repetition of that which appears.

The design consists of a central octagonal figure, A, having an ornamental border, B, and an ornamental center-piece, D, consisting of a group of leaves and flowers. On four sides of the octagon are arranged oblong figures E, each of which has a central radial ornament, a, and is further ornamented by springs b, clearly shown in the drawing. Square corner-pieces F are arranged adjacent to the remaining four sides of the octagon, each of these corner-pieces having a central ornament, f, and minor ornamentation too clearly shown to need description.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—
1. The design for the central octagonal figure
A, with its ornamental border B and ornamental center-piece D, as shown and described.

2. The design for the oblong ornaments E,

as shown and described.

3. The design for the square corner pieces F, as shown and described.

4. The design for the whole pattern, including the central octagonal figure A, oblong ornaments E, and corner-pieces F, as shown and described.
