## DESIGN FOR BREASTPIN.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEONARD S. BEALS, of Astoria, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a new Design for Breastpin, of which the following is a specifi-

The nature of my design is fully illustrated in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

This invention relates to a rustic work design, consisting of three branches of trees, A B C, which are connected together at their inverted bases D. From the bases D the three branches diverge downward in such a

manner as to form a symmetrical triangular figure. Between the branches are situated buds E of fuchsias.

The design for a breastpin, substantially as shown and described.
