

DESIGN FOR INKSTANDS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,201, dated March 9, 1875; application filed February 26, 1875.

[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OTTO F. FOGELSTRAND, of Kensington, and county of Hartford and State of Connecticut, have invented and produced a new and original Design for an Inkstand, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying engraving, to which reference is made.

A represents the base; B B, the ink-receptacles, and C C, the pen-rack. The foot of the base A is plane sided, with portions removed so that the corners form legs upon which it rests. The remainder of its sides consists of a tapering band ornamented by sunken lines, both curved and straight, as shown. Sur-

rounding the ink-receptacles B B, there are four sunken ornaments, consisting mainly of leaflets. Between the ink-receptacles B B, there is a recess or box, back of which there is an ornamental figure, consisting of fine sunken curved lines. The base of the post which form the pen-rack C C, are cylindrical, and provided with a bead, as shown.

What I claim as my invention is— A design for an inkstand of the form shown, and ornamented in the manner above described.
