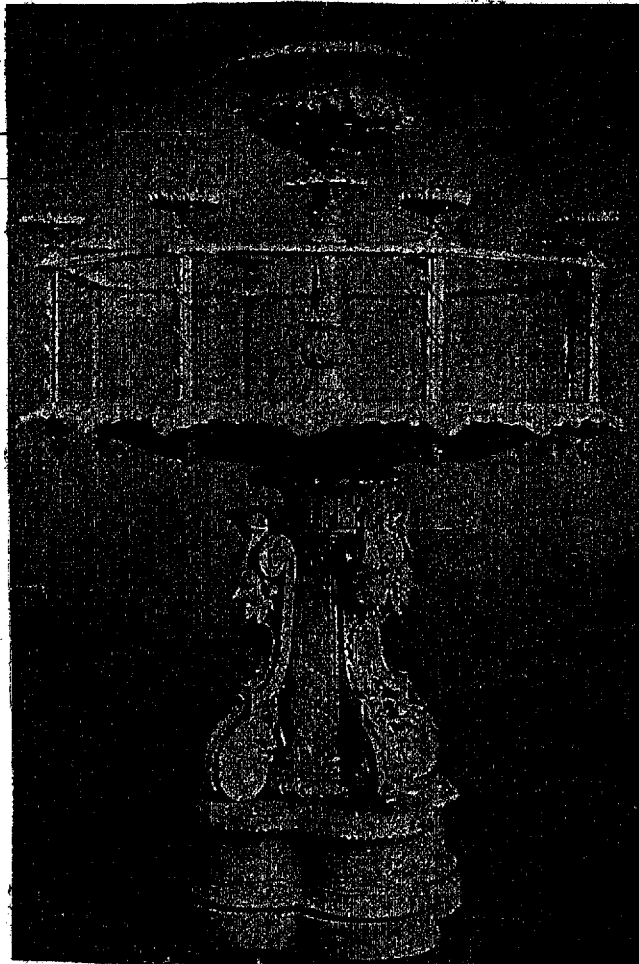

DESIGN FOR AQUARIUMS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **8,206**, dated March 16, 1875; application filed February 26, 1875.
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH W. FISKE, of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented certain Improvements in Designs for an Aquarium, of which the following is a specification:

My invention consists of a design for an aquarium; and the nature of the design is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

The body is octagonal in form, and is composed of an ornamental bottom, basin-shaped, from which rises eight vertical ornamented posts, connected at their top by a horizontal frame or rail, as represented in the illustration. At each corner there is secured to the top rail, over the posts, a cup-shaped plate, ornamented on its exterior, intended to support pots or other holders of flowers, and un-

derneath each post a pendent ornament is secured to the basin. In the center of the body there rises an ornamental column, on which rests an ornamented vase, to be used either for containing flowers, or as a miniature fountain. The whole is supported on an ornamented column having a capital and side ornaments composed of inverted scroll-brackets and figures of flowers and fruits, with an enlarged or projecting base of corresponding form, as represented, the whole forming a highly-ornamental design for an aquarium.

What I claim as my invention is—

The design for an aquarium, substantially as herein shown and described.
