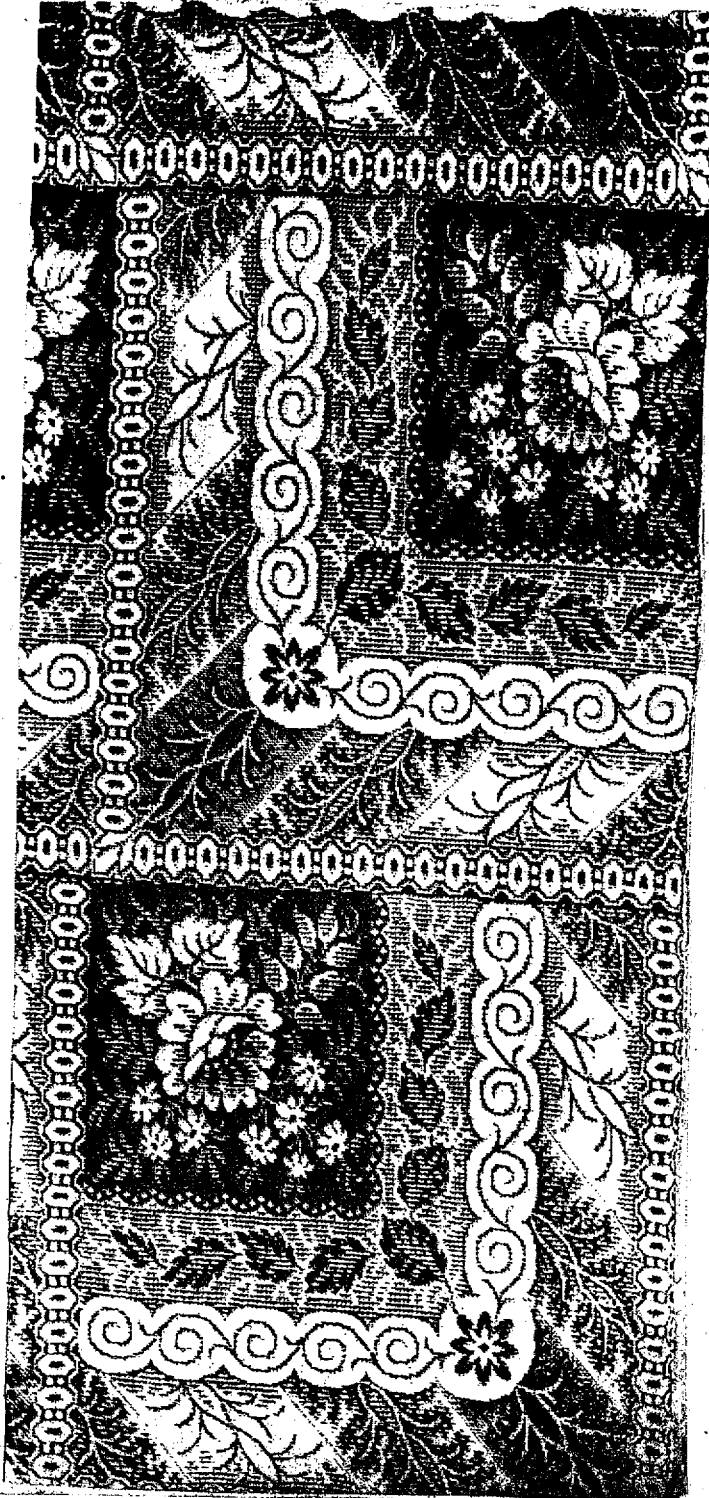

## DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **S,208**, dated March 16, 1875; application filed February 15, 1875.  
[Term of Patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented or produced a Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration; and consists of a square figure, A, ornamented with flowers, leaves, and sprigs, and bounded on two sides by bands *a*, *b*, and *d*, the outermost band *a* being ornamented by diagonal sprigs *f*, the band *b* having a corner ornament, *i*, and a scroll, *j*, and the innermost band *d* being ornamented by a series of leaves. The figures described are grouped together to form the entire pattern, the adjacent groups being separated by bands *h*.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—  
1. The design for the square figure A, as shown and described.

2. The design for the angular border, comprising the ornamented bands *a*, *b*, and *d*.

3. The design for the group, comprising the square figure A and angular bands *a*, *b*, and *d*.
