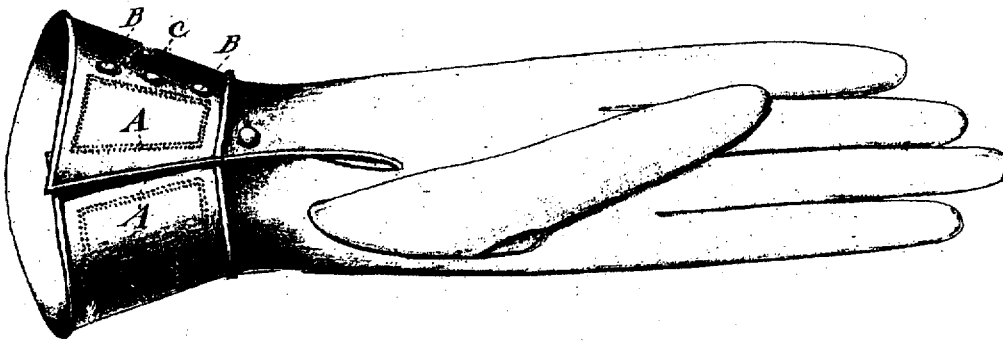
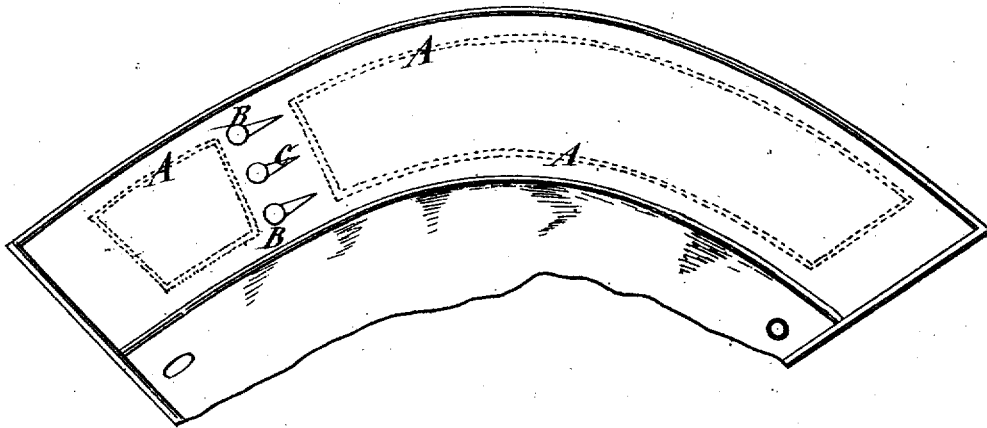

DESIGN FOR A GAUNTLET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **S;209**, dated March 16, 1875; application filed January 2, 1875.
[Term of Patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, BYRON G. SHULTS, of Johnstown, Fulton county, New York, have invented a Design for Trimming Gauntlets, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a glove-cuff is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made, the same consisting of the figures A, wrought in white or bright colored stitches of silk, each side of the buttons B,

and the pointed silk figures C, in connection with the buttons.

I claim as my invention—

A design for a glove-cuff, formed of the figures A B C, substantially as illustrated in the accompanying drawing.
